In addition, if violation(s) remain uncorrected after you receive a 30-day Notice of Violation, further enforcement action(s) will include additional fees.

- If you do not contact your inspector to discuss why you cannot comply or if applicable, complete the Property Owner Certification form and the re-inspection verifies that all violations have not been corrected, you may be charged for inspection and administrative costs, which can total \$2,665.00.
- The City may also abate the violations and charge you for the contracting and administrative costs, which can also total over \$1,000.00.
- Priority Lien fees in the amount of \$1,349.00 may be assessed if fees are not paid within 30 days from the date of the invoice.
 Charges may be collected by recording liens on your property and adding the charges to your property taxes or by filing in Small Claims Court.
- The Notice of Violation may be recorded on your property with associated fees for processing and recording.

You have a right to appeal this Notice of Violation. You must complete the enclosed Appeal form and return it with supporting documentation in the enclosed envelope. If Code Enforcement Services does not receive your written Appeal within the appeal deadline dated: 4-2-2018 you will waive your right for administrative review. Note: Incomplete appeals including, but not limited to an oral notification of your intention to appeal, a written appeal postmarked but not received by us within the time prescribed or a written appeal received by us without a filing fee are not acceptable and will be rejected.

Note: The appeal period may be reduced based on prior noticing i.e., Courtesy notice, Repeat Violation and the Property Owner Certification on record.

If you choose to file an appeal no further action can be taken by Code Enforcement Inspectors until you have had the opportunity to be heard by an independent Administrative Hearing Examiner pursuant to the Oakland Municipal Code Section 15.08.380 (B)(3) and a Final Decision is determined. An appeal will be scheduled within 60 days from the end of the appeal period. A filing fee in the amount of \$110.00 is due at the time of submittal. 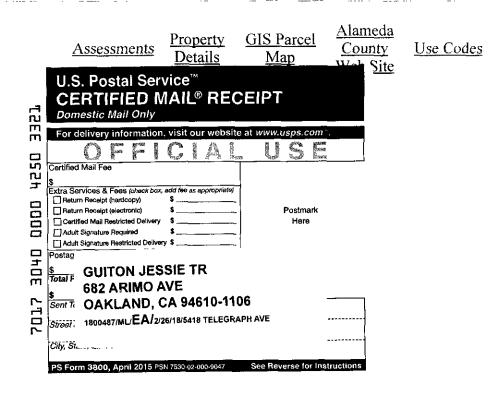
