RESOLUTION CONFERRING AUTHORITY UPON
THE CITY MANAGER AND THE SUPERINTENDENT
OF STREETS TO ACCEPT AND CONSENT TO
RECORDATION OF DEEDS OR GRANTS OF REAL
PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF OAKLAND.

RESOLVED: That deeds or grants conveying any interest
in or easement upon real estate to the City of Oakland for public
purposes shall be deemed accepted for recordation by consent of the
City of Oakland as grantee when the same shall be evidenced by
certificate of acceptance executed by the City Manager or the Super-
intendent of Streets attached to the deed or grant, all pursuant to the
provisions of Section 27281 of the California Government Code.

Will you please see to it that this revised procedure replaces that heretofore conformed to.
