Summary:

On 3 Sep 13, at approximately 1001 hrs, I was dispatched to 2439 66th Ave on a reported stolen vehicle.

I arrived at approximately 1010 hrs. I spoke to (V-1) Knight, who told me the following:

Between 3 Aug 13 and 8 Aug 13, V-1 had his motorcycle 1982 Honda, Knight Rider 450, Black (license plate [REDACTED]), locked in storage unit [REDACTED] at 6201 San Leandro St (self storage). V-1 returned to the area where his

motorcycle was secured and noticed that his storage unit was broken into (lock on gate was cut off) and his motorcycle was gone.

V-1 gave no one permission to take, borrow, use, or possess his vehicle. The keys to the motorcycle were with the motorcycle, but the motorcycle is un-drivable because it is missing the gas tank, carburetor and seat.

I checked the area for the motorcycle with negative results.

I verified V-1's identity by his CA CDL. I ran a motorcycle registration check on my computer, and confirmed the vehicle is registered to V-1.

I advised V-1 that he would be responsible for all towing and storage charges when and if his vehicle is recovered, and he agreed.

I phoned OPD communications, and spoke with dispatcher 4627 C/O. She confirmed that the vehicle cleared tow/repo and that she would enter the vehicle into the SVS.

I checked the area in which V-1's motorcycle was last located with negative results. There are no known witnesses. I relocated to 6201 San Leandro St (Self Storage) in an attempt to obtain surveillance footage and determine the means of access to the storage unit, but was unable to make contact with anyone.

It appears that unk suspect(s) gained entry into V-1's storage unit and removed the motorcycle it from its location. The suspect(s) then fled the scene in an unk DOF.
