



- 75% Waste Reduction Goal By 2010
 - > 1989 AB-939 50% by 2000
 - > 75% Goal Adopted in 2002
 - > Where We Are Now: 55%
- Zero Waste Goal by 2020
 - Adopted by Council 2006
- Urban Environmental Accords
 - > Signed by Mayor Brown 2005
 - > To be presented to Council for adoption 2006
 - Zero Waste Goal = Action four (4)
