Narrative:

On 03 Oct 13, I was working as OPD patrol unit 1L08. I was driving fully marked OPD patrol vehicle #1840, and I was dressed in full OPD uniform.

At approximately 0800hrs, I was dispatched to investigate the report of a stolen vehicle at 3055 Richmond Blvd.

I arrived on scene at approximately 0810hrs, I made contact with ORTEGA, Edwin (V1) who stated the following:

On 02 Oct 13, at approximately 2130hrs, V1 parked the vehicle (CA PLATE: [REDACTED], 2004, FORD, E250, VAN, WHI in Color) in the private drive [REDACTED]. V1 parked doors locked, and windows rolled up. On 03 Oct 13, at approximately 0700hrs, V1 returned to where the vehicle was last parked and observed that it was missing. V1 checked the area and could not find the vehicle. V1 reported the incident to police.

V1 did not give anyone permission to drive, take, borrow, use, or possess the vehicle. V1 can account for all keys to the vehicle possession.

V1 will assist with the prosecution of any arrests associated with the theft of this vehicle.

I ran a vehicle registration check on my computer, and confirmed that the vehicle is registered to V1.

V1 provided me with valid CDL. I advised V1 that if the vehicle is found the registered owner would be responsible for all towing and storage fees associated with recovering the vehicle. In addition, V1 provided me with the title to the vehicle.

I phoned OPD COMM. OPD COMM confirmed that the vehicle has not been towed or repossessed. I had OPD COMM enter the vehicle into the SVS.

I checked the area where the vehicle had been parked. There were no signs of broken glass; therefore it is unknown by what means the vehicle was taken.

I drove around the area, I did not locate the vehicle or any additional information about the crime.

I advised V1 to not recover the vehicle if it was located and to contact the police before entering the vehicle.

There are no known witnesses.

Based on my interview with V1, along with my training and experience, we believe the following occurred:

During the above stated time frame, unknown suspect(s) took V1's vehicle which was parked in the private driveway at 3055 Richmond Blvd, using unknown mean(s), without V1's consent, and with the apparent intent to deprive V1 of possession of the vehicle.
