ORDINANCE No. 10287 C.M.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-7.02 OF THE
OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE INCREASING THE SEWER
SERVICE CHARGES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oakland as
follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 6-7.02 through 6-7.07 of the Oakland
Municipal Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 6-7.02 IMPOSITION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGE.

Every party in whose name sewage disposal service of the East Bay Municipal
Utility District is granted shall pay a charge as herein provided for the use of
sewer facilities owned and operated by the City.

(a) A monthly charge of Four Dollars and Seventy Cents
(\$4.70) per family unit is hereby established and assessed, and applicable to
all billings on and after January 1, 1983 after final passage of this ordinance
by City Council, for the use of sewer facilities for residential premises
consisting of four or less family units.

(b) For residential premises not included in (a) above
a charge based upon the cubic feet of water used on the premises, and
applicable to all billings for consumption cycles commencing on and after
January 1, 1983, will be made for the use of sewer facilities, which charge
shall be computed and levied as follows:

Thirty Cents (\$0.30) per 100 cubic feet for
the first 40,000 cubic feet per month.

Eighteen and One-Third Cents (\$0.183) per
100 cubic feet for over 40,000 cubic feet up
to 400,000 cubic feet per month.

Eight and One-Third Cents (\$0.083) per 100
cubic feet for over 400,000 cubic feet per
month.

In no case shall the total monthly charge be less than
Twenty-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$23.50) per month.

(c) For premises in the District's "Commercial," "Industrial," and "Public Authority" business classifications, a charge based upon the cubic feet of water used on the premises, and applicable to all billings for consumption cycles commencing on and after January 1, 1983, will be made for the use of sewer facilities, which charge shall be computed and levied as follows:

Thirty Cents (\$0.30) per 100 cubic feet
for the first 40,000 cubic feet per month.

Eighteen and One-Third Cents (\$0.183) per
100 cubic feet for over 40,000 cubic feet
up to 400,000 cubic feet per month.

Eight and One-Third Cents (\$0.083) per 100
cubic feet for over 400,000 cubic feet per
month.

In no case shall the total monthly charge be less than Four Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$4.70) per month per account.

(d) The applicable volume of water upon which the charges established and assessed in sub-paragraphs (b) and (c) shall be based will be determined as follows:

(1) For premises where no portion of the water received from any source is consumed in manufacturing or is removed from the premises by means other than sewers, the sewer service charge shall be applied against the total amount of water used from all sources, as ascertained by the District for sewage disposal service charges imposed by such District within the City.

(2) For premises where a portion of the water received from any source does not flow into sewers, because of manufacturing or removal by other means, the sewer service charge shall be applied against the volume of water discharging from such premises into sewers, as ascertained by the District for sewage disposal service charges imposed by said District within the City.

(e) The charges established and assessed in sub-paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) shall become due and payable on receipt of bill therefor. Such charges shall be paid directly to the City or to the District, as directed upon the bill.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1983.


