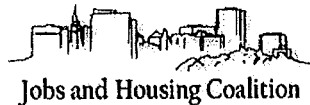



San Francisco Bay Area Fleet Week, which includes air show practices and demonstrations, is scheduled from Thursday, October 8th through Monday, October 12, 2015. Air show performers will include the U.S. Navy Blue Angels and other military aircraft performers who will be based and utilizing the North Field at Oakland International Airport.

Blue Angels practice sessions are scheduled on Thursday, October 8th starting at approximately 1:00 pm, subject to weather conditions. The Fleet Week air show is scheduled on Friday, October 9th to Sunday, October 11th, starting at approximately 2:55 pm each day, subject to weather conditions. During practice sessions and the air show demonstrations, airport neighbors may experience an unusual level of aircraft activity and noise. 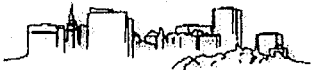

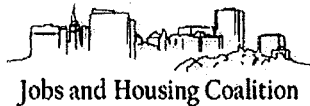


