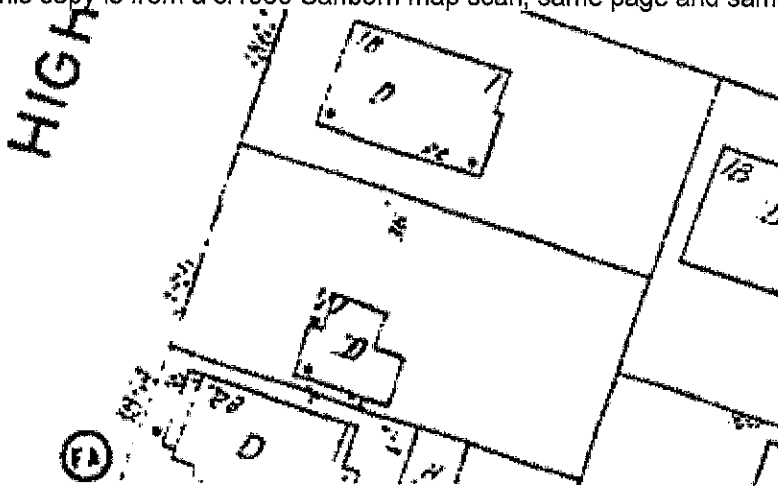

The most recent Sanborn map update is about 1970, so it shows the site "before 1981." Page 733 of the c.1970 maps shows a small L-plan 1-story house set about 25' back from the street and located along the southwest side of the lot. This copy is from a c.1950 Sanborn map scan, same page and same building as on the 1970 version.



Our 1996 field notes for 3856 High Street indicate that we saw a building that appeared to be from the 1920s with some remodeling. That is also what I seem to see on Google Maps.

Below is what I find in PTS. PTS records start in 1988. For something built around 1981 one would need to check the microfiche in the Building Department. The 1998 permit to "replace wood foundation" seems odd if the house was built around 1981.
