On 10 Apr 12, at about 1900 hrs, I was working as OPD patrol unit 3J15 with Ofc K. Yslava 8913P. We were both wearing full OPD utility uniforms and I was driving fully marked OPD patrol vehicle #1790. I was driving E/B on 580 at Grand Ave when dispatch notified us that officers in unmarked vehicles from the Antioch Police Department were following a murder suspect who was also traveling E/B on I580.

Dispatch gave us the license plate and description of the vehicle (Dodge Caravan, whi, CA plate directed us to its position. We spotted the suspect's vehicle as it exited Fruitvale Ave from E/B I580 and made a S/B turn onto Fruitvale Ave. We advised dispatch of our location and we continued following the vehicle for about two miles while we waited for the arrest team to locate the vehicle. Ofc I. Padilla followed behind us and provided dispatch with updates of the suspect vehicles location. The suspect drove the speed limit and obeyed all traffic laws as we followed behind him. At no point in the incident was a vehicle pursuit initiated. The suspect stopped the vehicle on his own, facing S/B along the west curb of the roadway across from 1420 24<sup>th</sup> Ave. The arrest team had not caught up to the suspect vehicle yet so Ofc. Yslava and I elected to conduct a high-risk-felony vehicle stop, in order to prevent the suspect from exiting the vehicle and fleeing on foot. I activated the red and blue lights after the suspect stopped the vehicle. Ofc. Yslava and I exited our patrol vehicle and intentionally pointed our firearms at the suspect who complied with our commands. I ordered the suspect to get out of the vehicle with his hands up, turn and face away from us and walk backwards to Ofc Yslava's position at the passenger side of our vehicle. Ofc. Nieves handcuffed the suspect without further incident.

Ofc Yslava notified Acting Sgt Worcester of the use of force at 1912 hrs.

Ofcs Yslava, Padilla, Nieves, Saeparn, Stanger, Vincelet, Mortimer, myself and Sgt. Wisecarber intentionally pointed our firearms at the suspect for the following reasons:

- The suspect was wanted for 187 PC so we believed the suspect could be armed.
- We were unable to see into the vehicle where the suspect could have access to a weapon without our knowledge.

Antioch PD took custody of the suspect and transported him to Antioch

No additional force was used or observed during the above incident.

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


