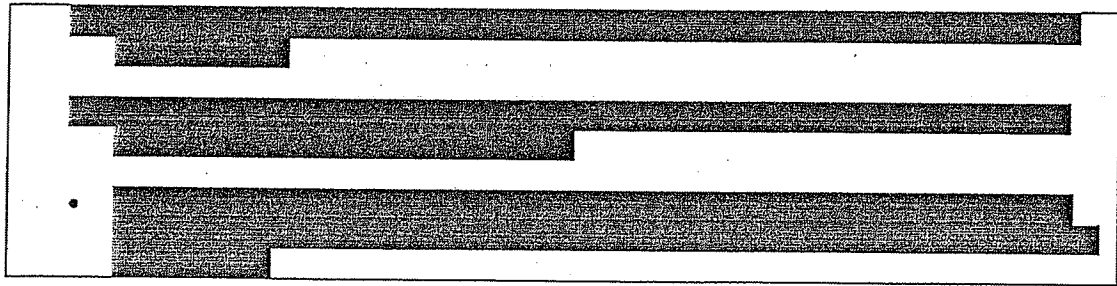




- During the two operational periods, Officer Fred Jenkins was the stand-by munitions expert. His role was to inspect pre/post outside agency deployment of such items.



assistance.

I was traveling N/B on Broadway and was directed to stop a 07 Niss TK KS lic. # [REDACTED]. The purpose of making the stop, was due to the listed vehicle violating several Ca. vehicle codes. I observed the veh stopped on the w/curb facing S/B in the 1200Blk of Broadway. I observed the suspect later ID as Cartmill standing at the r/pass door. It appeared he was having a conversation with the occupants of the veh. I proceeded through the intersection and observed Cartmill walking away from the vehicle carrying a white colored mask. Base on my experience, training and knowledge, anarchist would wear such mask in an attempt to conceal their identity, when they are committing acts of violence and vandalism in the downtown area, I made a U-turn and position my patrol vehicle directly behind KS lic. [REDACTED] for the purpose of conducting an enforcement stop. Cartmill look in my direction and immediately walked back over to the r/pass side of the vehicle and once again began a conversation with the occupants of the vehicle, while looking back in my direction.

I was now facing in a S/B direction in the 1200Blk of Broadway at a red traffic signal, directly behind the listed vehicle. I did not want to conduct the enforcement stop at this location, due to a small group of protesters that were located in the immediate area and I knew from prior incidents any type of enforcement activity near the group would incite them and most likely have them act out against the presence of law enforcement personnel in a negative manner. Cartmill remained along side of the vehicle until the light turn green and immediately walked IFO my vehicle and stopped facing in a E/B direction. Cartmill was acting as if he did not observed my vehicle behind the listed vehicle. The listed vehicle immediately made a V/B turn onto 12th St out of my view. I then pulled my vehicle forward and blew my vehicle horn. Cartmill then turned and faced me and appeared he pretended to be shock to my presence and raised both his hands into the air. I yelled from inside of my vehicle to get out of the way as I attempted to maneuver my patrol vehicle around Cartmill. He then immediately sidestep in a E/B direction and slammed both his hands on the hood of my vehicle and yelled out "Stop". I subsequently was able to maneuver my vehicle around Cartmill in order to assist in making the enforcement stop on the listed veh.

Cartmill was aware of my presence during the entire incident and refused to comply with my commands.

Cartmill was subsequently taken into custody by Sgt. I. Ramirez and Ofc. K. Bui. See their supplemental reports for further details. I relocated to 9th/Clay St and I positively identified Cartmill.

I did not observed any force being used. I did not use any force during the incident.

PDRD was activated.

No known witnesses.

Sgt. W. Lau was on scene and approved the arrest.

| Narrative On 25 OCT 13 at around 2015 hrs, I was working as Video Team 1 with Ofc. J. Yu and Sgt. I. Ramirez at the Occupy protest event. We were all wearing full OPD BDU uniform and operating out of non marked vehicle #1965. We were parked on the 500 BLK of 14th St facing east, when I saw a black Nissan car with four occupants driving eastbound on the 500 BLK of 14th St. I noticed the passenger side rear occupant had on a white mask and I know from my training and experience that subjects who wear these types of mask at protest events are usually anarchist that commit acts of vandalism. The reason why they wear these masks is because they are trying to hide their identity. I advised Ofc. J. Yu and Sgt. I. Ramirez of what I saw and we elected to follow the vehicle. We followed the vehicle as it turned south on Broadway. When we got to around the 1200 Blk of Broadway, I saw a marked OPD patrol vehicle driven by Sgt. K. Reed get behind the vehicle above. At around the same time, I saw a white male later identified as Cartmill, James (S-1) step off the sidewalk into the lane of traffic in front of Sgt. K. Reed's vehicle. Sgt. K. Reed activated his vehicle's horn and S-1 did not move out of the way. I saw S-1 raise his hands up in the air and then slam his hands onto the patrol vehicle. Sgt. K. Reed then went around the SUBJ and made a westbound turn on 12th and continued following the black Nissan. It was apparent to me that S-1 was trying to impede and prevent Sgt. K. Reed from conducting a traffic enforcement stop. After Sgt. K. Reed went around the SUBJ, I saw Sgt. I. Ramirez step out of our patrol vehicle and detain S-1. I assisted with the detention by holding S-1's right arm while Sgt. I. Ramirez placed handcuffs on S-1. After we detained S-1, I saw a crowd began to gather at our location and yelling obscenity at us. Ofc. J. Yu conducted a quick pat search of S-1 for weapons, we placed him in the back of our vehicle, and then relocated to the 500 Blk of 10th St. When we re located to the 500 Blk of 10th St, I was assigned to control traffic while Sgt. | Narrative On 25 Oct 13, at about 2016 hours, I was working as OPD Occupy Oakland Detail as Video Team 1 with Sgt. I. Ramirez and Ofc. K. Bui. We were all wearing full police utility uniforms and I was driving non-marked patrol vehicle 1965. Our detail assignment included video surveillance of the protest and identifying individuals who violate lawful orders. Our patrol vehicle was parked on the 500 block of 14th St facing EB on the south curb when Ofc. Bui observed a black pick up truck driving EB on the 500 block of 14th St. The vehicle's license plate was [REDACTED]. The front passenger and driver of this vehicle appeared to be wearing "V for Vendetta" masks. I know from training and experience that individuals who dawn these masks during Occupy Oakland protests are known anarchist. Their purpose for donning these masks are to protect their identities as they vandalize buildings or public property. The V for Vendetta masked individuals call themselves "Anonymous". This group is known to be destructive to public property and hostile towards law enforcement officials. We elected to follow this vehicle as it went SB on Broadway St from 14th St, in the number 2 lane. The vehicle came to a stop on the NW corner of 12th St and Broadway St, facing SB. I observed a MW (later identified as James CARTMILL; S1) stepping onto the foot guard of the front passenger side door and reach into the vehicle. S1 then produced a V for Vendetta mask from inside the vehicle. After S1 retrieved the mask, he dismounted from the foot guard and remained standing on the roadway. S1 was about 2-3 feet away from the pedestrian sidewalk. Simultaneously, Sgt. K. Reed 7639 was driving NB on the 1200 block of Broadway St in fully marked patrol vehicle 1437. Sgt. Reed elected to turn his patrol vehicle around and detain the vehicle [REDACTED] for a vehicle stop. As Sgt. Reed pulled his patrol vehicle behind the vehicle [REDACTED] the vehicle drove WB onto 12th St from Broadway St. All this occurred at the same time and I observed S1 remaining on the roadway to purposely stand in front of Sgt. Reed's patrol vehicle. S1 raised both hands in the air and shouted at Sgt. Reed to "STOP". Sgt. Reed activated his horn to tell S1 to move away from the front of the patrol vehicle. I saw S1 grin at Sgt. Reed and intentionally remained in the front of Sgt. Reed's patrol vehicle again. I believed that S1 did so to prevent Sgt. Reed from following the vehicle [REDACTED]. S1 possibly did so to allow the vehicle [REDACTED] to flee the area with the unidentified occupants which are possibly apart of the anarchist group "Anonymous". Sgt. successfully maneuvered his patrol vehicle around S1 and continued WB on 12th St to relocate the vehicle [REDACTED].

Because our vehicle was directly behind Sgt. Reed's vehicle, we on-viewed the aforementioned incident.

At this time, Sgt. Ramirez elected to arrest S1 for 148(a)PC - Resist/delay/obstruct an officer.

I put the patrol vehicle in "park" as Sgt. Ramirez exited the vehicle to arrest S1. Ofc. Bui, who was sitting in the rear passenger seat, exited the vehicle as well to assist Sgt. Ramirez. Upon exiting the patrol vehicle to assist, I activated my PDRD.

Sgt. Ramirez took control of S1's right arm and Ofc. Bui took control of S1's left arm. S1 was escorted to the hood of our vehicle, where Sgt. Ramirez placed handcuffs on S1 without incident.

I provided crowd control against S1's associates who were video taping the arrest.

As we were attempting to arrest S1, we observed a group of 35-45 bicyclist traveling SB on the 1400 block of Broadway St. I heard over my radio that this group of bicyclist were apart of the Occupy Oakland Protestors "Pedal against the Pigs". We believed that the group of bicyclist were coming to our location to possibly lynch S1 from our custody.

This was also the time that other platoons were instructed to demobilize and we no longer had additional officers available in the area.

Due to the rapidly changing environment, which caused for great concern for our safety and the safety of other officers in the area, we elected to remove S1 from the area. I conducted a pat search of S1's rear pockets and waist line for weapons. I removed a set of red pliers from S1's rear left pocket and S1 was placed in the rear of our patrol vehicle for the temporary transport.

We safely transported S1 to the 500 block of 10th St, which was a secured location away from the protesters.

As Sgt. Ramirez processed S1 for his arrest, I assisted Sgt. J. Asunius with perimeter security on the east crosswalk of 10th St and Clay St. Sgt. Ramirez advised me that S1 also has a traffic warrant from San Francisco, Ca. S1 was also taken into custody for this warrant.

I conducted a full search of S1's backpack incident to arrest as well as for the purposes of storing S1's backpack for Safe Keeping in the OPD Property Section. Prior to search S1's backpack, I asked S1 if he had any illegal items inside. S1 told me that he has a medicinal marijuana card and may possess a small amount of marijuana inside his backpack. I advised S1 that if marijuana or any perishable foods are located inside his backpack, they will be removed. S1 was aware that any perishable foods will be discarded and any marijuana will be submitted for destruction. During my search of S1's backpack, I located a clear plastic bag containing a green leafy substance of suspected marijuana. I submitted this into OPD Criminalistics for destruction.

I completed a OPD Safe Keeping Form for S1's backpack which contained his camera, personal belongings, and V for Vendetta mask. I also placed S1's ID card into his backpack. I provided S1 with a copy of the Form and advised him that he can recover this from the PAB Property Section at a later time.

S1 was transported by Ofc. R. San-Andreas and Ofc. S. Loris via patrol wagon 1396.

I did not locate any witnesses to this incident.

No use of force used or observed.

Ofc. Bui and I had our PDRD's activated.

| <p>On 25 OCT 13 I was assigned to work Video Team 1 for the Occupy Oakland Protest that was occurring. Officer J. Yu, 9127 and Officer K. Bui, 9109 were working as part of the video team, driver and cover officer. We were in OPD utility uniforms, in unmarked 1965. Throughout the day we were tasked with filming the crowd, and sending a live video stream to the EOC, for situational awareness.</p> <p>At about 2015 hours, we were parked in the 500 block of 14th Street, against the south curb. Officer Yu was driving and Officer Bui was in the rear/drivers side seat. Officer Bui advised that he had seen a truck pass by, and the passengers were wearing "Guy Fawkes" masks. I advised Officer Yu to follow the vehicle to see where it was going. I know from my training and experience, that anarchist sometimes use masks to hide the identity when they plan on committing crimes such as vandalism. We followed the vehicle as it turned south bound onto Broadway. We were a couple of car lengths behind the truck when I observed the truck pull over to the west curb just north of 12th St. The vehicle was partially in the #2 lane of traffic. I observed SUSP1, later identified as CARTMILL talking to the passengers of the truck, on the passenger side. I then observed a marked patrol vehicle, driven by Sgt K. Reed, make a u-turn and get immediately behind the truck, as if it was going to make a traffic enforcement stop. We were directly behind the patrol car. The truck pulled slightly forward, and I observed SUSP1 step into the roadway in between the patrol vehicle and the truck. SUSP1 then threw up his arms as he faced the patrol vehicle standing very close, so that Sgt Reed could not maneuver around him. The truck turned onto 12th St, WB. Sgt Reed honked the horn and attempted to move around SUSP1. SUSP1 yelled at Sgt Reed. Sgt Reed eventually made it around SUSP1 and went after the truck.</p> <p>Because I observed SUSP1 step into the roadway, immediately in front of Sgt Reeds vehicle, and then failed to move out of the way, standing directly in front of the car, I believed that SUSP1 was intentionally interfering/delaying Sgt Reed, to allow the truck to get away from the vehicle stop. As Sgt Reed made his way around SUSP1, SUSP1 walked toward the west sidewalk. I decided to detain SUSP1 for 148(a) PC. I immediately exited the vehicle and grabbed SUSP1's right arm and escorted him to the hood of the unmarked vehicle. I placed handcuff on SUSP1 without incident. I advised radio and asked for the officer who had been delayed by SUSP1. Sgt Reed advised that he was the officer, and that SUSP1 was arrestable for 148PC. As this was occurring, other protesters were approaching our location on bicycles.</p> <p>We quickly placed SUSP1 into our vehicle, to relocate, fearing that the protestor might attempt to lynch SUSP1 from our custody. 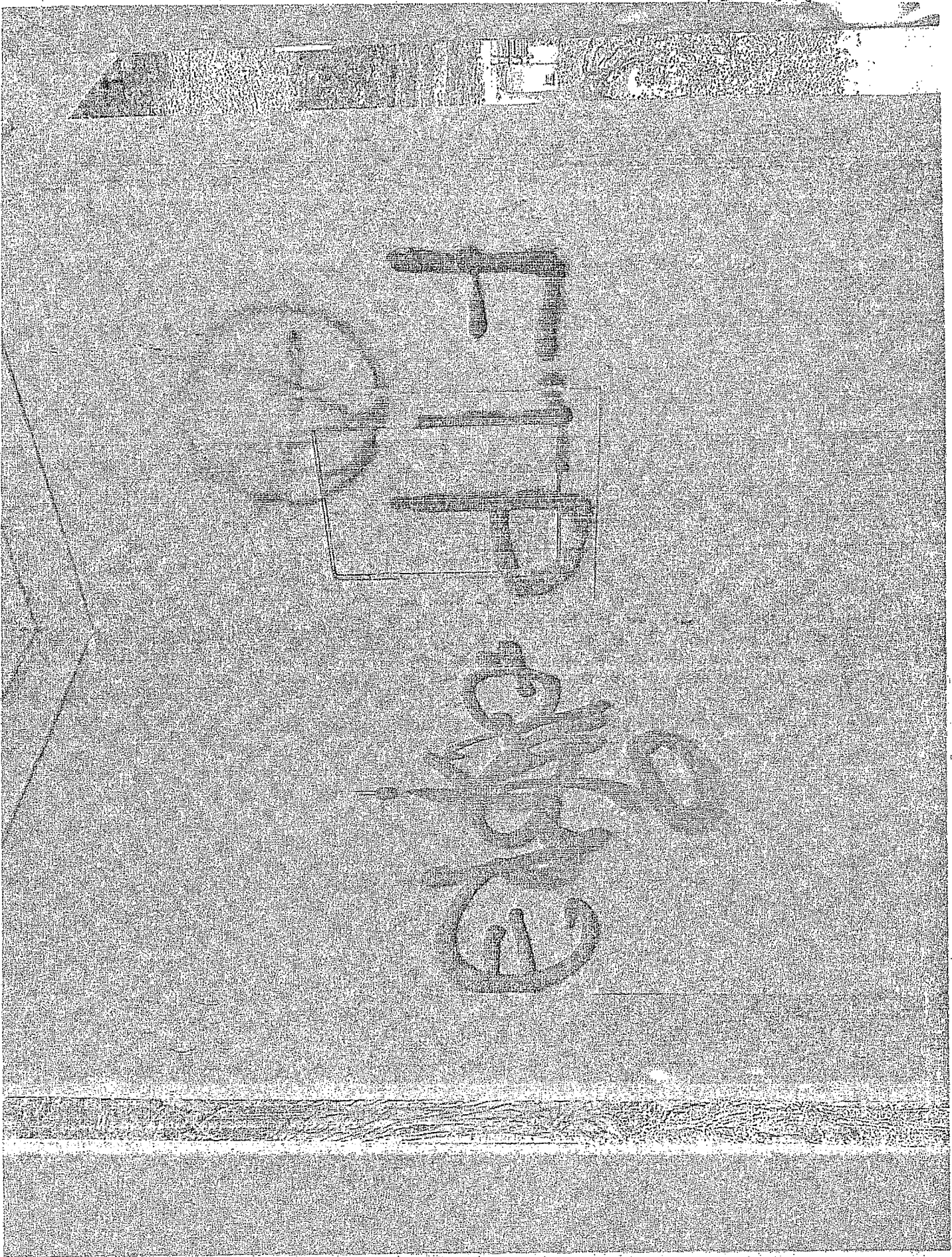

I was standing approximately 100 feet north of the Pergola at Lake Merritt, 599 El Embarcadero. There were about 20 people with bicycles listening to music and dancing inside of the Pergola. This group had left the Occupy Oakland protest some time earlier and had ridden their bicycles around Oakland, at times taking up all lanes of traffic, until they ended up in the Pergola. | | | | |
| As I was standing in the park north of the Pergola with the TNT and bicycle officers, an unknown refused couple approached us from the direction of the Pergola. The male said he did not want to be involved, but there was graffiti "going on" inside of the Pergola. | | | | |
| A short time later, the rest of the motor detail arrived. The group began to leave with members leaving in different directions. As they were leaving TNT announced via the loudspeaker to the group all traffic laws would be enforced. The group left the area. | | | | |
| At about 2130hrs a group of about 10 bicyclists, from the same group who were inside of the Pergola, were individually stopped for specific vehicle code violations near Bay St and Vernon St for various violations of the vehicle code (refer to the supplemental reports for details). 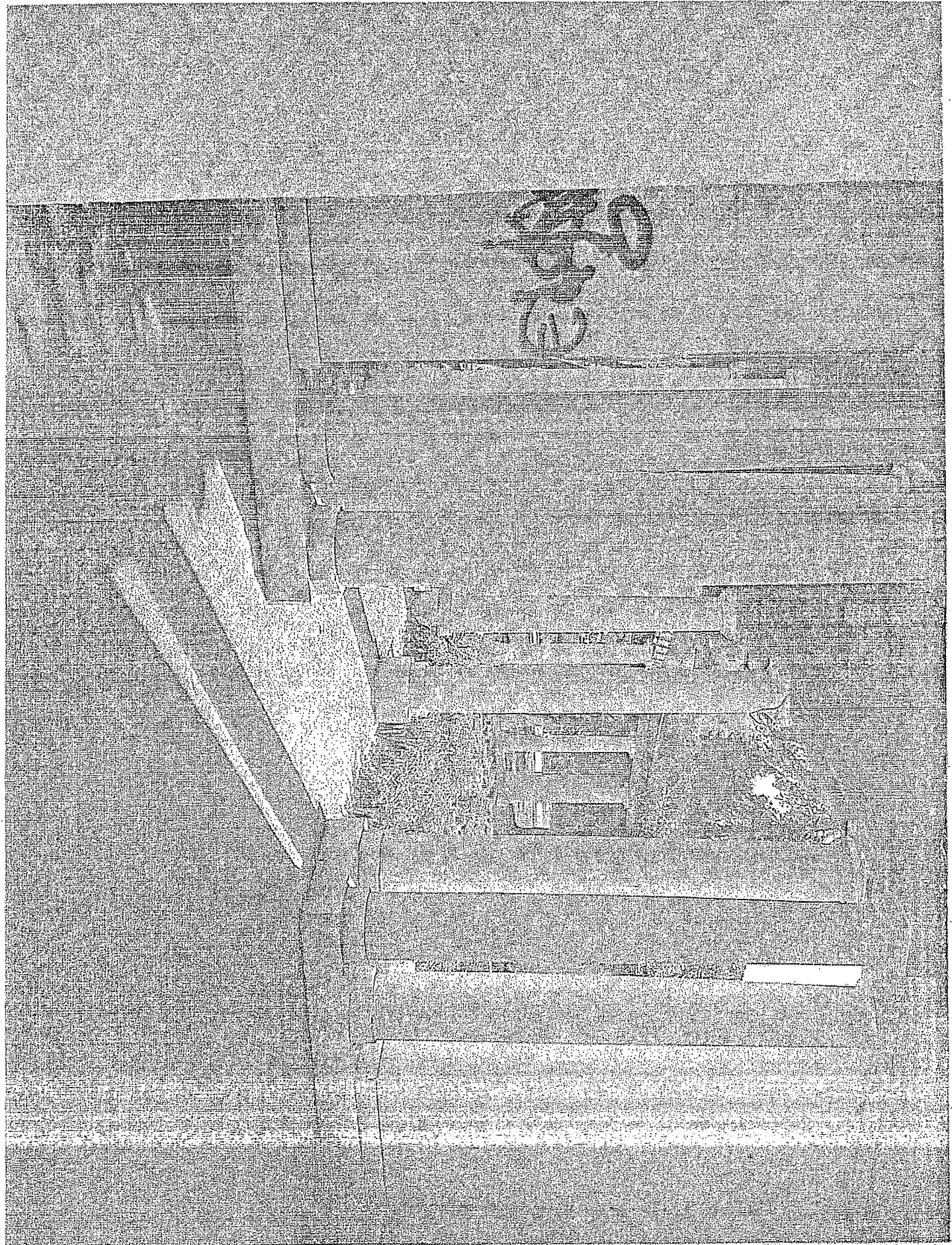
