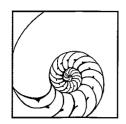

The following progress report describes work performed by Lamphier-Gregory and our team of associated subconsultants for the Coliseum Area Specific Plan and EIR Project. This report corresponds to Invoice #31201-9572, addressing the billing period from 08/17/13 through 10/13/13.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### Task 1: Project Initiation and On-Going Coordination

During this period, Lamphier-Gregory attended regular Thursday afternoon meetings with the ENA team and City staff to confirm work schedules and products, and coordinated the efforts of other members of our team. The schedule for these meetings has been adjusted to include an every-other week meeting on progress and issues related to the Specific Plan and every off week to discuss overall EIR and coordination with the ENA team.

- Lamphier-Gregory received, and distributed to the full EIR/Plan team, a copy of the ENA team's draft Master Plan document, which will serve as the basis for development of the EIR's detailed analysis as well as a fundamental "scenario" pursuant to the Specific Pan.
- During this period, Lamphier-Gregory prepared an overall schedule of expected deliveries and review cycle for the Specific Plan and the EIR.
- Lamphier-Gregory prepared and distributed to the City team a Project Description "framework" paper describing the different elements and relationships between the ENA Master Plan, the City's Specific Plan and the detailed vs. broader analysis of various elements of the Master Plan/Specific Plan.
- Lamphier-Gregory continued to coordinate the efforts of the large subconsultant team, fully engaging SWA into the Specific Plan writing process, and meeting with City staff regarding issues such as land use and urban design guidelines.
- Lamphier-Gregory and Hausrath Economics worked with the ENA team to verify and "proof" the underlying development assumptions of the Master Plan (number of residential units and square feet of non-residential space by types) on a parcel-by-parcel basis. Once these land assumptions were resolved, Lamphier-Gregory distributed these underlying development assumptions to the EIR team for their use in preparation of various technical studies.

• Work pursuant to the budget reallocation and shift in approach for both the Specific Plan and EIR was been initiated, and formal changes in the agreed scope of work are still in preparation.

#### Task 2: ENA Team Technical Support

The Specific Plan/EIR team continued to provide planning support efforts to the ENA team regarding economic and environmental issues relevant to the Master Plan design.

#### Hausrath Economics

HEG's effort focused on providing input to and conferring with the ENA team on market potential for science and technology development, building product types, obtainable rents and other parameters for assessing development feasibility, and development parameters for master Plan scenarios.

#### Task 3: Draft Specific Plan

#### **SWA**

SWA became fully engaged in Specific Plan production during this period. early products prepared already include a mock-up Specific Plan document with expected table of contents and materials expectations, and evaluation of the ENA team master Plan, development of the 'tribased" land use approach, and multiple discussions with the ENA team and Specific Plan team. SWA also began participation in the every-other-week team meetings with City staff.

#### Hausrath Economics

HEG's efforts pertinent to the Specific plan focused on on-going work with Lamphier-Gregory and the ENA Team to refine and finalize the development scenario for the Specific Plan and its subsequent EIR; including preparation of tables for existing conditions, future buildout and the change over time. HEG also strategized with Willdan and other team members regarding the financial strategy for the Implementation Element of the Specific Plan. The above effort included six working meetings with team members, and communications with City staff.

#### Willdan Financial

During this period, Willdan continued worked toward preparation of conceptual infrastructure financing plans to be included in the Specific Plan, as well as formulation of financing strategies for the stadium, coordinating with HEG and the ENA team on these efforts.

#### **Tasks 4: Draft EIR**

During this period, Lamphier-Gregory and the EIR team continued our environmental analysis of the master Plan and buildout assumptions. Meetings and calls with each of the EIR subconsultants have continued on a regular basis to provide updated direction and information relative to the current Project Description and schedule.

#### Hausrath Economics Group

HEG provided baseline buildout numbers for use by Fehr & Peers in their traffic analysis including land use, population and employment estimates for use in the traffic model and for use in the Population and Housing chapter of the EIR.

#### Fehr & Peers

Continuing their work on the EIR, Fehr & Peers completed the following in documenting existing conditions at the project site:

- Conducted field work at the 108 study intersections to verify intersection configuration and observer traffic operations during weekday AM and PM peak periods
- Conducted preliminary traffic operations analysis of the 108 study intersections
- Obtained freeway traffic volumes and conducted preliminary freeway operations analysis
- Conducted field work to document existing pedestrian, bicycle, and transit facilities in the vicinity of the project
- · Obtained transit ridership data from AC Transit and BART and summarized data
- They also attended meetings with City of Oakland staff and project team.

#### **BKF** Engineers

During this period, BKF continued efforts to define and estimate costs associated with on-site infrastructure. They also began preparation of a water demand estimate for submittal to EBMUD relative to a request for a Water Supply Assessment. Based on the updated Project Description numbers (see task 1 above), the water demand estimates were updated and revised accordingly.

#### **RGDL**

During this period, RGDL continued preparation of the existing setting section of the Noise chapter of the EIR, including conducting noise measurements during game-day events (baseball and football) at the Coliseum as well as noise monitoring of traffic noise and ambient conditions in and around the Planning area.

#### **SLR International**

SLR International (formerly SES Engineers) continued preparation of the existing setting section of the geology and hazardous materials section of the EIR, gathering additional relevant existing data from known regulatory data bases, confirming the current status of contamination remediation efforts within the Subarea A (Coliseum) site, and developing risk-based corrective actions and preliminary cost estimates for hazardous materials remediation requirements.

#### **BUDGET STATUS**

The following spreadsheet provides a budget summary for this project as of September 13, 2013. Budget allocations do not yet reflect the re-allocations between subconsultants as described above, but will be re-allocated at the point where modifications to the City/L-G agreement have been completed.
