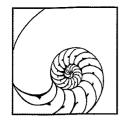

The following progress report describes work performed by Lamphier-Gregory and our team of associated subconsultants for the Coliseum Area Specific Plan and EIR Project. This report corresponds to Invoice #31201-9669, addressing the billing period from 1/047/13 through 01/31/14.

SCOPE OF WORK

Task 1: On-Going Coordination

During this period, Lamphier-Gregory attended regular Thursday afternoon meetings with the ENA team and City staff to confirm work schedules and products, and coordinated the efforts of other members of our team. We also attended other, non-scheduled meetings including:

- 1/10 meeting with BKF to discuss analysis and assessment of creek realignment options and PG&E transmission line relocations
- 1/13 meeting with SWA to coordinate inclusion of creeks and power line relocation into the Specific Plan document
- 1/27 meeting with City staff to discuss and review overall comments on Admin Draft EIR #1
- 1/28 follow-up meeting with City staff to continue review and comment on Admin Draft EIR #1

The schedule for these meetings has been adjusted to include an every-other week meeting on progress and issues related to the Specific Plan and every off week to discuss overall EIR and coordination with the ENA team.

Task 3: Draft Specific Plan

SWA

During this billing period, SWA Group overhauled the look and feel of the Specific Plan document, adding imagery and additional context information so that the Plan would be more

visually interesting and dynamic. SWA also worked to respond to staff comments on the text of the document as well, incorporating edits and revisions as well as supplementing the text with new technical information from members of the technical subconsultant team. Admin Draft Plan #2 was provided to City staff as a graphics package on 1/30, with the MSWord version closely following during the current (next) billing period. SWA participated in City/ENA/ Specific Plan team meetings on 12/12 and 12/18.

BKF Engineers

During this period, BKF finalized their recommendations for re-routing of on-site main electrical transmission lines and realignment and engineering for Elmhurst Creek to accommodate the proposed new Stadium site.

Tasks 4: Draft EIR

Lamphier-Gregory and the team of technical environmental consultants completed and submitted Administrative Draft EIR #1 for City staff review and comment on 12/18.

During this billing period, most of Lamphier-Gregory's efforts were spent on making and coordinating the changes, revisions and additional analysis needed in response to City staff comments, and toward preparation of Admin Draft EIR #2. Submittal of Admin Draft EIR #2 is planned for the 2nd week of February.

BKF Engineers

During this period, the Water Supply Assessment as requested from EBMUD by BKF Engineers was provided, enabling BKF to finalize their water demand analysis and conclude their wastewater analysis for buildout of the Plan. They also provided engineering strategies and environmental performance standards necessary to be implemented as part of an Elmhurst Creek realignment effort to culvert flood flows of this creek.

Garcia and Associates

During this period, Garcia & Associates responded to City staff comments on the biology and cultural resources chapters of the Administrative Draft EIR #1. Much of this effort focused on technical changes regarding known cultural resources, and reconsideration of originally suggested mitigation measures which can be better characterized as detailed implementation of City standard conditions of approval and other permit processes likely to be required.

Environ

During this period, Environ continued to provide detailed technical studies for inclusion in the Draft EIR chapters on Air Quality and Greenhouse Gas. This work included a traffic-based health risk assessment, re-calculations of air quality and GHG emissions from the Coliseum Site and from Plan buildout, and preparation of cumulative air quality and GHG analyses.

Fehr & Peers

During this period, Fehr & Peers attended meetings with City staff and the project team, and continued their work on the following EIR-related tasks:

• updating the 2035 traffic volume forecasts for 108 study intersections under 3 different scenarios, and

• preparing the transportation chapter of Admin Draft EIR #1, which was submitted to the City for review on 12/9.

BUDGET STATUS

The following spreadsheet provides a budget summary for this project as of January 31, 2014. Included within this spreadsheet and invoice is a subconsultant invoice for Willdan Associates from July/August of 2013, which had been overlooked in our prior invoice submissions.
