On 24 AUG 12, I was working as OPD patrol unit 1L22. I was wearing full OPD uniform and driving fully marked OPD patrol vehicle 1808. I was dispatched to 2520 Rampart St, to investigate a 459 PC. It should be noted that this crime occurred on 22 AUG 12, and the Victim called OPD several times to make a report.

I made contact with V1, who told me his house was broken into. V1 told me the following:

On 22 AUG 12, V1 left his residence locked and secured at 0600 hrs. V1 came home at approximately 1600 hrs on 22 AUG 12. When V1 walked to his front door, he noticed someone had kicked open the front door. The front door was kicked off its hinges. V1 walked into his residence and saw that someone had conducted a messy search of the living room and bedroom. V1 noticed someone had moved his computer from the desk to the living room. V1 further noticed his flat screen TV was off the wall mount. V1 walked into his bedroom and saw that someone conducted a messy search and took 2 rings, 1 necklace, and two signed baseball cards.

V1 gave no-one permission to enter his house or remove any items.

I advised V1 of security measures that may deter any future burglaries, such as

- 1) Alarm
- Neighbor watch
- 3) Cameras
- 4) Dog

I did not request a Technician for prints because there was no printable surfaces at the scene.

On today, 23 AUG 12, I was asked to switch over to the service channel. When I switched over, I was informed that I needed to respond to a priority Technician Call. I asked the dispatcher for more information regarding the priority call, or words to that effect. I received instructions to contact the Radio Sergeant for further. Upon calling the Communications Center, I discovered SGT. Leroy JOHNSON was the on-duty SGT.

Once I contacted SGT. JOHNSON, I was advised that the report, a burglary, had been made on-line. The Incident type was a burglary which had been assigned a temporary number of T12010924, on 23 AUG 12, at approximately 1611 HRS.

I advised SGT. JOHNSON that a Technician's response, on such an incident, was in violation of policy and protocol. I noted immediately upon reviewing the call that the extent of policy violations warranted addressing once I'd cleared call, especially since I was being ordered to respond. I did as ordered and responded to the scene.

The victim, Mr. CHANEY informed me that he did not believe anyone was going to respond. He also informed me that he'd been waiting for an officer since the day before, but none had responded. I asked him if he'd canceled the request for an officer to respond and he replied, "No". I asked him if any officers had contacted him. He stated I was the first person to come to his residence. Mr. CHANEY informed me that he had contacted his City Council member and her assistant. He also informed me that one of his neighbors had provided him with a license plate number. The victim also believes his neighbor had a surveillance camera.

Based upon the information that the complainant provided me, it appears he and neighbors have investigative leads. Prior to leaving complainant's residence, I informed him that I would report this matter to my clearly identified supervisor, SGT. Randy POPE. Other matters noted are being reported to the appropriate investigative authority.

Mr. CHANEY had stills on his camera that shows his home in a ransacked condition. His home had since been cleaned up and items were placed back with no particular care. The front door, which was reportedly the point of entry had been repaired and secured. Given the exception of the damage to complainant's front door, he appears to have suffered no other loss. Both a computer and large display had been left at scene. Many of the

surfaces were textured and or were poor for fingerprinting.

I processed scene for fingerprints with use of black fingerprint powder and a fiberglass brush. I developed the following lifts:

L1 Interior - right side of "APPLE" display beginning 1/4" below its top edge.

L2 Interior - right edge of "APPLE" display, 9" below top edge.

L3 Interior - left edge of "APPLE" display beginning 1/2" below its top edge.

I developed no other lifts from the residence. Those lifts listed are likely to belong to one of the residents.

I advised the victim to keep pictures that he'd captured on his phone, for insurance purposes.

I went to my vehicle and provided the victim with a resource card, an item normally provided by a responding officer. I also provided the victim, Mr. CHANEY, which had been added to call after the protocol violation had occurred. No officer(s) responded to the scene while I was there.
