RESOLUTION APPOINTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING PROTESTS IN RELATION TO THE PROPOSED MAINTENANCE OF STREET LIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHING OF ELECTRICAL ENERGY FOR LIGHTING MARKET STREET BETWEEN 7TH STREET AND SAN PABLO AVENUE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 19766 C. M. S. AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS THEREFOR HERETOFORE ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION NO. 19759 C. M. S.; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK AND CLERK OF THE COUNCIL TO GIVE NOTICE OF SAID HEARING AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW; AND DESIGNATING THE NEWSPAPER IN WHICH SAID NOTICE SHALL BE PUBLISHED.

WHEREAS, the City Clerk and Clerk of the Council has presented to this Council for consideration that certain report entitled "Report of the Superintendent of the Electrical Department in the Matter of Market Street Lighting District No. 6," which said report has been made by the Superintendent of the Electrical Department in accordance with the "Street Lighting Act of 1919" of the State of California and as directed by Resolution No. 19252 C. M. S., passed by this Council on January 27, 1948.

AND WHEREAS this Council has by Resolution No. 19766 C. M. S. declared its intention to order street lighting equipment to be maintained and electrical energy to be furnished, for a period of one year, for lighting Market Street between 7th Street and San Pablo Avenue; and adopted plans and specifications therefor by Res. No. 19759 C. M. S. passed April 22, 1948; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That Thursday, the 20th day of May, 1948, at 31 minutes past 7 o'clock p. m. in the Council Chamber in the City Hall, Oakland, California, be and the same are hereby appointed as the time and place for hearing protests in relation to the aforesaidproposed improvement of Market Street between 7th Street and San Pablo Avenue, in accordance with Resolution of Intention No. 19766 C. M. S. and in accordance with the "Report of the Superintendent of the Electrical Department in the Matter of Market Street Lighting District No. 6," as filed by said Superintendent with the City Clerk and Clerk of the Council on April 22, 1948; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk and Clerk of the Council be and he is hereby directed to give notice of said hearing by causing notices to be posted and published, all in the manner and for the time and in all other particulars as prescribed by the "Street Lighting Act of 1919" of the State of California. Said notice shall be published in the Oakland Tribune, a daily newspaper published and circulated in the City of Oakland, which newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose.
