

Introduction and Overview

This proposal is for the <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> -- a medical cannabis dispensary and resource center for patients. The goal of this business proposal is to create a top-quality resource center and dispensary, meeting the highest standards of ethical and responsible operations, to be run in a manner that the community can be proud of, and which will make a positive contribution to the surrounding commercial area and to city generally.

Top standards of cleanliness, respect for our neighbors, ethical treatment of workers and customers, and environmental sustainability will be adhered to. The atmosphere will be respectful and attractive, including displaying art by local artists, using recycled, organic, and sustainable products, hiring locally, patients with disabilities and paying workers a living wage.

<u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will adhere to Green Business certification standards of environmental practices. (Information about Green Business certification can be found at: http://www.greenbiz.abag.ca.gov/)

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will work actively to promote neighborhood safety and positive community relations, and to provide resources and supportive information for patients. Our goal is to make sure that people from all walks of life feel welcome, particularly including seniors, people of all sexual orientations, ethnicities, and genders, and persons with disabilities, and to ensuring a secure, non-discriminatory, and health-oriented environment.

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will include, in addition to a medical cannabis dispensary, support and information services for patients. Such support services will include counseling and support groups, a lending library of books and other informational materials, acupuncture, therapeutic massage, and patient support luncheons, along with referral resources to help patients access other services that they may need. For example, the Center will compile information about regional services such as organizations for cancer patients, soup kitchens, job training programs, and other programs that our patients may need, and will provide referrals for patients.

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> is interested in having a collaborative process for choosing our location, to maximize effectiveness and minimize any community opposition. We are willing to work with the City of Oakland to select an appropriate location, and to work closely with neighboring businesses to promote harmonious relations with the surrounding area. We believe the ideal location would be one that is served by frequent public transit, that is part of a commercial strip with pharmacies, cafes, and other amenities, and one in which the surrounding community is supportive. In our plan below, we explore our suggested location based on these factors, and we are willing to consider other locations if appropriate.

<u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will operate with an awareness of and welcoming attitude toward the diverse communities that give Oakland its strength. The entire space will be wheelchair accessible, and will include sufficient bathroom facilities for customers that are also wheelchair accessible.

Purple Heart Patient's Center will be operated by Keith D. Stephenson, who lives locally in the city of Oakland. Mr. Stephenson is a homeowner in

Mr. Stephenson, as an African American man and a person with a disability, has a deep awareness of and commitment to accessible, non-discriminatory services and will provide a facility that promotes these values. Keith D. Stephenson has extensive experience in marketing, small business, and medicinal marijuana services.

<u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will be involved in, and contribute toward, the improvement of the community.

Mission Statement

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> is committed to promoting a healthy, responsible, community-minded environment to serve the needs of medical marijuana patients. We will provide a clean and comfortable atmosphere, with a focus on organic and environmentally-sound products, support services for patients, and responsible relationships with the wider community.

Keys To Success

Several factors will help <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> become successful. These include:

- <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will be managed and operated by local people that know the medicinal marijuana market and has extensive in the community. <u>Keith D.Stephenson</u>, the ooperator, also has worked at the Oakland Cannabis Buyers Cooperative and at The Zoo dispensary in procurement and done extensive small business consulting for dispensaries, work that will be valuable experience to draw from. In addition, he has been prescribed cannabis for *ankylosing spondilitis*, a degenerative form of arthritis and is empathetic to the needs of the disabled. Keith D.Stephenson has also been appointed to the Citizen Review Panel for Measure Z.
- The location is accessible by public transit, (ideally, we would like to be near a BART station and on a corridor with frequent bus service). <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will also encourage access by bicycle, and on foot or wheelchair. The Center will provide secure bicycle parking, and provide transit information, for staff and patients.
- Having experienced managers, promoting an ethic of responsible service, continual training for employees, and career growth opportunities for employees will lead to the best service.
- A clean, healthy, and wholesome atmosphere full of positive energy.
- Providing a comfortable atmosphere, and including support services for patients.

Location

<u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> understands that location is very important to success and positive operations. <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> is proposing to lease a space at 578 West Grand Ave, previously used as a dispensary or 415 4th street.

<u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> can help promote synergies to help neighboring businesses by attracting customers. Other food-related and health-related businesses are nearby, several quality restaurants, and bookstores which focus on self-help and spiritual growth topics.

In addition, a growing number of seniors are expressing interest in medicinal marijuana. Due to a combination of factors, including the rising costs and frequent side effects of pharmaceutical drugs, more and more seniors are interested in natural healing remedies, including medicinal marijuana. A 2004, survey conducted by the AARP found that 72% of seniors nation-wide believe that medicinal marijuana should be made available to those in need. In the geographic breakdown, an even higher 82% of seniors in Western states supported access to medicinal marijuana. By providing a comfortable atmosphere, and being located in an area where seniors can easily feel welcome, the <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will help ensure access to these patients, who appear to be underserved currently.

Demographic Information

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> is aware that understanding and relating well, with the area surrounding the Center will be essential to our success and community harmony. As a result, we are willing to work collaboratively with the City of Oakland to select a location, and we will research any potential location, and do advance work with area residents and businesses to ensure positive community relations.

The proposed locations of the <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> are 578 W. Grand Ave and 415 4th street.

Size Of Space Needed:

Target size is 2,200 – 4,000 square feet.

Start up Capital:

Service Plan

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will provide support services for patients, with the goal of promoting health and wellness, and ensuring that patients have access to informational materials.

The <u>Purple Heart Patient Center</u> will provide the services listed below, and will also continue to be in ongoing dialog with our patients to ensure that we are meeting their needs, and the needs of the community. Thus, if patients request a new service beyond our original list, we will strive to provide it, and to expand to meet the needs of our community as appropriate.

Services:

- Peer support groups for patients
- Counseling groups (with professional counselors) for patients
- Massage Therapy daily by students from National Holistic Institute
- Acupuncture daily by students from the Academy of Chinese Culture
- Reference Library (books and educational materials on medicinal marijuana, health, wellness, and natural healing, nutrition, and related topics)
- Monthly luncheon for patients
- Social program referral: Reference material (and available staff member who can assist with referrals), to provide information on job training programs, food banks, health clinics, and other support services patients may need.
- Hiring program for local residents, including hiring persons with disabilities
- Public transit maps and bicycle route maps made available
- Classes on cultivation for patients to produce their own medicine
- Monthly patient care packages and sliding scale for limited income earning patients
- Award points accrual for each purchase redeemable for future medicine

Ownership, Management, and Staffing:

The Purple Heart Patient Center will be set up as a 501(c)3 non-profit mutual benefit association to provide assistance to patients. It will be managed by Keith D. Stephenson who will be very hands on and heavily involved in day-to-day operations, while also hiring a team of talented, compassionate employees.


The manager has leadership and oversight experience, including having served as a lead aviation maintenance technician supervising over daily projects and coordinating the logistics of ordering aircraft parts, inspection and returning planes to service. The manager has extensive experience as a union shop steward and has developed effective conflict resolution skills. As a result, our Security Plan, in addition to including all of the required elements of the City of Oakland's cannabis dispensary policy, will include additional innovations to ensure public safety.


