Narrative:

On 23 Jan 14, I was working as OPD Patrol Unit 1L14. I was driving fully marked OPD patrol vehicle #1451, and I was dressed in full OPD wool uniform.

At approximately 0755hrs, I was dispatched to the [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED] Santa Clara Ave, [REDACTED] to investigate the report of a possible dead body on arrival. OFD requested OPD for the coroners.

I arrived on scene at approximately 0800hrs.

OFD Truck E-10 were on scene.

OFD Firefighter and Paramedic B. Kelly P22285 pronounced YOUNG, Ruth (V1) deceased at approximately 0710hrs. Paramedic B. Kelly P22285 advised that there does not appear to be any signs of trauma to the body.

I observed V1 lying on her back, on her bed, in her bedroom. I observed that V1's head was pointed in a western direction, while her legs were pointed in a eastern direction. I did not observe any signs of trauma to V1's body.

V1 was dressed in a BLU/WHI Shirt with flowery designs. A blanket was laid atop of V1's body.

I made contact with [REDACTED] (RP) who stated the following:

[REDACTED] On 22 Jan 14, at approximately 2200hrs, RP was at V1's residence. RP could hear that V1 was breathing. On 23 Jan 14, at approximately 0630 hrs, RP went into V1's room to check on V1. RP observed that V1 was unresponsive, cold to the touch, and wasn't breathing. RP called OPD.

Ofc D. Ly took a written statement from OP1. See OP1's statement for additional details.

I canvassed the area for witnesses with negative results.

There are no known witnesses.

I made contact with ALCO Deputy Horn via land wire. She advised that the deceased body of V1 could be released to RP. ALCO REPORT NUMBER 14-00254.

Based on the condition of V1's body, her age, her personal history, witness statement, along with my training and experience, I believe the following occurred:

[REDACTED] On 22 Jan 14, at approximately 2200hrs, RP was at V1's residence. RP could hear that V1 was breathing. On 23 Jan 14, at approximately 0630 hrs, RP went into V1's room checked on V1. RP observed that V1 was unresponsive, cold to the touch, and wasn't breathing. OFD arrived on scene and attempted to render medical aid. V1 was still unresponsive. OFD declared V1 deceased on 23 Jan 14, at approximately 0710hrs. ALCO coroners authorized the release of V1's body to RP.

On 23 Jan 14 at about 1336 I was working as 1L22 driving marked car 1458. At this time I was dispatched to a DOA with OFD Engine 8 on scene.

Upon arrival I met with OFD Engine 8 Kenny Ergun. I was given a prehospital care report and EKG printout. I was advised that V-1/Carter was pronounced at 1230 hours. OFD advised that there was no trauma and the victim had a myriad of preexisting medical conditions including [REDACTED]

I entered the residence and saw the victim on the floor of the front southwest bedroom on the floor. She had been moved there by OFD.

I met with W-1 [REDACTED] and took a statement from her. [REDACTED] said that the last time she saw the victim alive was at 1745 on 22 Jan 14 in the kitchen when she left the home. When she returned, [REDACTED] was advised by [REDACTED] that it appeared that V-1 was in her bed sleeping. [REDACTED] went to bed. She got up the next morning and did not check on V-1 until about 1130. Other times before she had looked in the room and believed that V-1 was breathing. When [REDACTED] checked on V-1, she found V-1 unresponsive. She called 911. (See [REDACTED] statement for details.)

I called ALCO Coroner and gave Tech Mendiola 233 the information concerning V-1.

I then spoke with ALCO Deputy Horn. After being advised of the circumstances of V-1's death, Horn released the body to the family. Refer to ALCO Coroner report 14-00261.

It appeared that V-1 died of natural causes. I advised 1L73 of the death.

PDRD was used on initial contact.

Narrative:

On 24 Jan 14, at about 0952hrs, I was working as OPD Patrol Unit 1L04. I was dressed in full police uniform and operating a fully-marked OPD vehicle #1789. I was dispatched to [REDACTED] 13th St [REDACTED] to investigate a report of a DOA called in by OFD.

Upon arrival, OFD Eng #1 was already on scene. I observed an elderly woman (later ID'ed as Rui WEN - V1) on her bed. V1 was lying on her back. Her head was pointed E/B & her arms and legs were pointed W/B. OFD Paramedic Fesai (Serial #21779) stated that upon his arrival, they observed V1 in her bed (in the same position). OFD stated that rigor had already set in. OFD pronounced V1 deceased at 0940hrs (24 Jan 14).

OFD provided me with a copy of the Alameda County Prehospital Care Report. Upon examining V1, there did not appear to be any signs of foul play. No technician was called to the scene.

Sgt J. Anderson was notified about the DOA and that it appeared to be natural.

Ofc T. Thurston took a written statement from [REDACTED] (P1) who appears to be the first person to discover V1. P1 stated that [REDACTED] P1 went to visit [REDACTED] his morning (24 Jan 14) at about 0900hrs. Upon her arrival, V1 was in her bed. V1 was not moving or breathing. V1 was lying on her back & would not wake up. P1 immediately pulled the medical alarm inside the apartment until OFD arrived. See written statement for further details.

On 24JAN14 at about 1522 hours I was working as 2J33 with my partner Ofc N. Windham 8658. We were wearing full police OPD wool uniform. I was driving marked patrol vehicle 1700. I was dispatched to [REDACTED] 89th Ave to investigate a DOA. Upon my arrival, I noticed PMP # 2139 was on scene as well as OFD #7. I made contact with OFD Paramedic J. Haugthy who explained to me that the deceased R. LIVELY (V1) was lying on the floor in the living room. Haugthy pronounced V1 dead at 1518 hours from what appeared to be natural causes.

I performed a safety check of the premise to ensure that there was no one else in need of medical attention. During my safety check, I did not locate anyone in need of medical attention. I also did not see any signs of forced entry or foul play.

While inside the residence, I located V1 lying on his back with his head pointing S/E and his feet point N/W. He was wearing black slippers, black socks, blue jeans, and what appeared to be a black T-shirt, and a plaid shirt. The T-shirts appeared to have been cut down the middle due to medical personnel rendering aid to V1. V1 also appeared to have miscellaneous medical items attached to him due to medical personnel rendering aid. I did not observe any visible injuries to V1.

I also spoke to paramedic Damon Victor (PMP) who told me the following:

When Victor arrived on scene, he located V1 lying on his back in the hallway with his head facing S/W and his feet facing N/E. Victor grabbed V1 from under the arms and moved his body into the living room so that he and other medical personnel may have room to render aid to V1. Victor continued to render medical aid to V1 until he was pronounced by OFD Paramedic Haugthy.

I then spoke to [REDACTED] (OP1) he stated that he [REDACTED] (OP2) are the ones who found V1. I took a written statement from OP1, in it he said:

On 24JAN14 OP1 picked up OP2 [REDACTED] 89th Ave around 1000 hours. When OP1 arrived, he noticed V1 was in good mental and physical condition. OP1 stated that he and OP2 were

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going to a funeral, but that V1 was going to stay home by himself. V1 suffered from [REDACTED] that had been a result of being [REDACTED] V1 was taking medication [REDACTED] for the above mentioned [REDACTED]

OP1 and OP2 left the house around 1000 hours and returned at 1510 hours. Upon their return they found the front door to be locked. OP2 unlocked the front door, and upon entering the home noticed V1 lying on his back in the hallway. OP1 noticed that V1 appeared to be unconscious. OP1 checked to see if V1 was conscious, but noticed he was non-responsive. OP1 then called 911 and attempted to render aid to V1. OP1 stopped rendering aid when medical personnel arrived on scene. OP1 stated that V1 has not had a [REDACTED] since around September of 2013. OP1 was unaware if V1 had any other medical issues. OP1 was also unaware when the last time V1 had been to the hospital. OP1 stated that there was no one else inside the house with V1 when they found him. See statement for further details.

I was unable to get a statement from OP2 due to her emotional state.

V1's main medical physician was Dr. [REDACTED]

I contacted the Coroner and informed him of V1's medical history, and that his [REDACTED] were caused by [REDACTED]. The Coroner informed me that they would pick up V1 and conduct an investigation due to the fact that his death may be related to the above mentioned incident as well as his age and overall health. Deputy A. Williams #1998 arrived on scene around 1851 hours and secured V1's body. Deputy A. Williams provided me with a Coroners receipt as well as the report number (2014-00274). Deputy A. Williams photographed V1's body.

Based off my investigation it appears that:

V1 was at home by himself on 24JAN14 between 1000-1510 hrs and suffered from some unknown medical issue which ultimately resulted in his death.

There was no technician available for photographs.

My PDRD was not activated during this incident.

I did not use force, nor did I observe any use of force.

I did not handcuff, search, detain or arrest anyone during this incident.

No known witnesses located.

I THEN MADE CONTACT WITH [REDACTED] (LISTED) WHO STATED THAT HE WAS IN ON HIS WAY OUT OF THE HOME. [REDACTED] SAID THAT HE THEN OBSERVED V-1 SITTING/LEANING AGAINST A HALLWAY WALL. Upon arrival, I spoke with OFD firefighter/paramedic HAUGHY # (Engine#20) told me the following:

On 25 Jan 14, at about 1150hrs, OFD arrived at [REDACTED] 104th Ave in response to a medical call.

Upon arrival, [REDACTED] (OP-1) directed OFD to [REDACTED]. When OFD initially attempted to open the bedroom door, HAUGHY said V1 was laying against the interior of her bedroom door obstructing entrance to her bedroom. HAUGHY said besides pushing open the door to access V1's bedroom, they did not move V1 or attempt to resuscitate her due to V1 being cold to the touch and having full rigor and independent lividity.

HAUGHY said V1 was without a pulse. No pulse was located and MASON (V1) was pronounced dead at 1154hrs. HAUGHY said he did not observe any signs of trauma to V1's person.

OFD remained on scene to provide scene security until OPD arrived.

HAUGHY provided me with the original copy of the EMS field notes, which I attached to this report.

I spoke with [REDACTED] (OP-1) who provided me with V1's doctors information. OP-1 said V1 did not believe in going to the doctor on a regular basis. All of V1's medication were prescribed to her in 2009 by DR. [REDACTED]

Summary:

On 27Jan14 at approximately 1250hrs I was assigned as OPD patrol unit 1L19. I was wearing full police uniform, and I was driving fully marked police unit#1747. At that time, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] 13th Ave to investigate a report of a DOA.

Upon arrival, I spoke with paramedic Miguel OFD Eng#4 who initially responded to the scene. He said OFD paramedic G. Kerisu, from Eng#4 pronounced WONG, Larry(V1) dead at 1221hrs. Paramedic Miguel told me they initially responded to this scene because they received a call of an asian male who was not breathing.

I entered [REDACTED] 13th [REDACTED] through the front door which was open. I saw WONG laying prone in the living room area, about 2' from the front door of the residence, without any clothes. WONG was prone with his head facing E /B and his feet facing W/B. WONG's arms were at his side, and it appeared that rigor mortis, and livor mortis had taken effect.

I did not observe any signs of trauma to V1.

I then contacted [REDACTED] OP1 who stated WONG(V1) [REDACTED] and she lives at [REDACTED]. She said on 26Jan14 at around 0100hrs she was with WONG [REDACTED] when he started to heavily drink vodka. She said WONG was [REDACTED] and was getting naked because he was getting ready to go to sleep. [REDACTED] said at that time, she left the home to go see one of her friends. When she did so, she locked the door and all other doors and windows were secure. [REDACTED] said she returned [REDACTED] around 0400hrs. She said when she entered, she used her key to unlock the front door and there was no damage or any indication of forced entry. Upon entering the residence [REDACTED] said she saw WONG laying face down on the floor about 2' away from the front door. She said she was not alarmed that he was on the floor, because WONG is a heavy drinker and frequently passes out for long periods of time. [REDACTED] said she left WONG there on the floor all day on 26Jan14 because she thought he was sleeping. [REDACTED] said she finally fell asleep at the residence, around 0200hrs on 27Jan14. She said when she woke up, she realized that

WONG was in the same position she last saw him and started to worry. She said she called out to him but he didn't respond, then she tried to move his legs and they were cold, so she decided to call 911. [REDACTED] said she has known WONG for several years [REDACTED]. She said WONG is a very heavy alcoholic and usually passes drunk about twice per week. She also said he had not eaten for a couple days and was complaining [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said, WONG told her that he [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said she did not see any injuries or anything else suspicious when she observed WONG. (See [REDACTED] signed statement for further details.)

I did not observe any signs of forced entry to the residence. All exterior windows and doors appeared to be secure. The interior of the home was disorganized and messy with empty bottles of alcohol strewn all over the floor. Ofc. J. Low also observed needles and pipe as drug paraphrenelia on the bed. I did not observe any signs of forced entry, physical struggle, or any other crime.

I contacted WONG's next of kin, [REDACTED] OP2) who said he would make funeral arrangements for V1. I learned from [REDACTED] OP2) that WONG(V1) death was somewhat expected due [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

Ofc. J. Low 8606 contacted ALCO Coroner. ALCO coroner deputy J. Hovda #1432 arrived and took possession of WONG's remains deputy Hovda provided me with their report# 2014-00306 and coroner's receipt# 34541.

I took a written statement from [REDACTED] P1).

V1's residence was secured by his next of kin.

I notified IL73, Sgt. R. White 8321P, that the death appeared to be from natural causes around 1305hrs.

It appears, sometime between 26 Jan 14 0100hrs and 27 Jan 14 1200hrs V1 died [REDACTED] [REDACTED] V1 was discovered by OP1 on 28 Jan 14 around 1200hrs who realized that was unresponsive and remained in the same position on the ground for several hours.

On 28 Jan 14 at about 0816 hrs, I was disp'd to 1501 78th Ave to investigate a report of possible death and was provided with the following details listed below via MDT (on board vehicle computer):

Upon arrival, I met with members from OFD Engine #29 and PMP# 2125, who were already on scene. Both OFD and PMP advised me that they received a medical call from [REDACTED] 78th Ave and discovered MW, later id'd as Eatherton laying in his bed unresponsive with rigor mortis and lividity had set in Eatherton's body. The OFD and PMP then directed me to a rear bedroom, where Eatherton slept and that Eatherton may have [REDACTED]

Upon entering the room, I saw Eatherton laying on the bed, on his left side with his head pointed west, with his left arm under his head. Eatherton's feet/legs were bent in 45 degree angle with his knee pointed north and feet pointed toward east. Eatherton was wearing a blue plaid shirt and maroon checker pajama pants. I obs'd that Eatherton was wearing a hospital identification band [REDACTED] on his left wrist, indicating that Eatherton may have been recently discharged from the hospital. I noticed that rigor mortis and lividity had set in Eatherton's body and that his body was cold to touch. I also checked any signs of violence/struggle, but did not find any signs indicating that there were violence/struggle before his death.

I checked around the area where Eatherton was sleeping and obs'd 1.75 liter Taaka Vodka which was 1/3 full, 4 different medication bottles containing pills, wrapped and unused [REDACTED] and other miscellaneous items such as cigarette box, batteries on the night stand, which was next to his bed. However, I did not locate any [REDACTED]

It appears that OFD and PMP pronounced Eatherton dead at about 0825 hrs.

I notified Sgt. Wong 8048 that the death appears to be natural.

On 28 Jan 14 I was working in patrol as a one (1) man unit 1L05. I was dressed in full police uniform operating out of fully marked OPD vehicle #1444. At approximately 1052hrs I was dispatched to [REDACTED] 5th Street to investigate a reported DOA.

On arrival I observed that OFD #E1 was already on scene. I met with Paramedic Mui #P20478 of the Oakland Fire Department who told me that a male adult in his 60's, identified by a California I.D card as Akbar Shaaf (V-1), had passed away in unit #3. Ofc Mui provided me with V-1's Cal I.D and the Alameda County Prehospital Care Report. Ofc. Mui further advised that he had pronounced V-1 deceased at 1033hrs on today's date.

I then spoke to a [REDACTED] R/P stated that on the afternoon of Friday January 24, 2013 she received a phone call from V-1's family advising that they had been unable to get in contact with V-1 for the past several days. R/P stated that [REDACTED] had also contacted her advising that they too had been unable to contact V-1. R/P stated that she then spoke to [REDACTED] and scheduled a 1030hrs time to meet at V-1's residence on 28 Jan 14 so that a well being check could be conducted.

R/P stated that she arrived at V-1's residence on 28 Jan 14 at approximately 1020hrs. R/P stated that at this time she observed several notes and business cards as well as the January rent receipt stuck in the security gate of V-1's front door that had not been collected. R/P stated that she then knocked on V-1's door and placed a phone call to V-1 with no response. R/P stated that [REDACTED] had not yet arrived so she asked V-1's next door neighbor [REDACTED] to assist her. R/P stated that she provided [REDACTED] with a key to V-1's apartment at which time he unlocked and opened V-1's security gate and front door for her. I entered the residence at which time I observed V-1 laying un-clothed on the floor in the kitchen area of his residence. V-1 was laying on his right side with his head facing in an east bound direction and his feet in a west bound direction. V-1 had a dark colored fluid oozing from his mouth and nose and appeared to have been deceased for an extended period of time. There was an overturned chair and several other objects on the floor in the area around V-1. I did not observe any visible signs of trauma to V-1 at this time and I observed NOTHING to indicate any involvement of foul play at this time.

I attempted to locate a contact phone number V-1's doctor (if any) and or any family members with negative results. At approximately 1110 hrs I notified the Alameda County Coroner's Office. I spoke to Deputy Hovda #1432 and explained the circumstances surrounding this incident at which time Deputy Hovda advised that he would be en route to recover V-1's body. At approximately 1235hrs Deputies Hovda #1432 and Gogna #1303 arrived on scene at which time I directed Deputy Hovda to V-1's unit and turned over V-1's Cal I.D and Key to him. Deputies Hovda and Gogna then processed the scene and removed V-1's body from the premises. Deputy Hovda advised that he observed NO signs of foul play at this time. On 28JAN14 at about 1500 hrs, I was working as OPD Patrol Unit 2L19. I was dressed in full police wool uniform, and I was driving fully marked police vehicle #1847. I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Dimond Ave. to assist OFD with a coroners request for a deceased person.

Upon my arrival, Ofc. J. Factora and I met with OFD Rig # E16, and PMP Rig # 2129. PMP units advised Ofc. Factora and I that the patient was in unit #308 with OFD. Once at unit #308, OFD stated the patient (V1) Rufiang CHEN was suffering from [REDACTED] and was just released from Summit hospital this morning. OFD stated V1 was later found by [REDACTED] ((OP1) [REDACTED] unresponsive who then called 9-1-1. OFD units said as they arrived, V1 was unresponsive and she was pronounced at 1430 hrs by PMP. OFD said they did not observe any signs of injury or trauma to V1 and her death appeared to be of natural causes. OFD released custody of V1 to me at about 1520 hrs and gave me a copy of the pre-hospital report.

I observed V1 lying on her back on her bed dressed in her pajamas. V1's head was facing the North, and her feet were facing South. V1's arms were laying at rest adjacent to her body. There were no signs of foul play or trauma to V1.

Ofc. Factora spoke with (OP1) [REDACTED] OP1 told Ofc. Factora the following details:

OP1 said on 28JAN14 sometime in the morning, [REDACTED] V1 was discharged from Summit Hospital for [REDACTED] s. OP1 said the doctor advised her that [REDACTED] needed to go home and rest. OP1 said at about 1400 hrs, she left V1 resting in her bed as she went to the laundry room to check on [REDACTED] OP1 said when she was done, she went back to V1 to check on her condition. Summary:

On 30JAN14 at about 0305 hrs. I was working as OPD patrol unit 3L26. I was wearing full OPD uniform and driving fully marked patrol vehicle #1832. I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Brookdale Av. to investigate an open telephone line after a 9-1-1 call. Dispatch could hear a woman crying in the background.

Upon arrival, I could hear people crying and sobbing in the residence. A male Hispanic [REDACTED] [REDACTED] opened the door. I immediately noticed a heavyset Hispanic male (later identified as Luis RODRIGUEZ (V-1)) laying on the floor of his bedroom. V-1 was laying on his left side with small pool of blood near his mouth. I requested a Code 3 ambulance at 0312 hrs. for a male that was unconscious and wasn't breathing.

I rolled V-1 over, so that he was laying flat on his back. I began doing chest compressions/first aid for several minutes. Ofc. Castro took over doing chest compressions. I then took over once again and continued doing chest compressions.

PMP Rig #2218 arrived at 0325 hrs. and began treating V-1. The paramedics stated that V-1 was cool to the touch (thus indicating an earlier time of death). When I stepped away from V-1, I noticed that V-1's hands were slightly blue in color.

OFD Engine #13 also arrived on scene, but PMP pronounced V-1 deceased at 0329 hrs.

I began speaking with the family members on scene whom provided information about V-1's medical history.

I was advised by the Coroner's Office, Deputy Unubun 1914 that the above medicine [REDACTED]

Based upon the above information, the coroner said the funeral home could come out and take custody of V-1 but that a hold would be placed on V-1 until his Doctor signs the death certificate.

The Coroner's case # is 2014-00335.

Based on the above information and my observations, I believe that V-1 died of natural causes due to his extensive medical history. There was no signs of anything suspicious.

Ofc. Castro took a statement from [REDACTED] (W-1) whom described how [REDACTED] had found V-1 at about 0305 hrs because she had gotten up to use the bathroom. She found it odd that V-1 was not snoring. She opened V-1's bedroom door and found V-1 laying on the floor. See the written and signed statement for details.

Tech. Jaecksch arrived on scene and took photos.

We remained on scene until the [REDACTED] arrived on scene and took V-1 away.

My PDRD was activated.

There were no uses of force.

On 31 Jan 14, at approximately 0825hrs, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] E 16TH ST to investigate the report of a DOA.

I arrived at approximately 0830hrs, I spoke to OFD fire fighter Holmes (engine 13), who told me the following:

On 31 Jan 14, at approximately 0814hrs, he, and OFD personal, received a dispatched call to respond to [REDACTED] E 16TH ST to investigate the report of a dead body. He and his crew arrived on scene at approximately 0817hrs. Upon arrival, Holmes spoke with (R/P) [REDACTED]. R/P told him that he had found [REDACTED] dead in the bedroom of the residence. OFD entered the residence through the front door and discovered (V1) Wesley, H lying on his back on top of the bed. V1 was unconscious, not breathing, non-responsive, and cold to the touch. OFD began medical aid to V1. OFD paramedic Holmes pronounced V1 dead at 0823hrs.

Holmes provided me with a pre-hospital care report, which I attached to this report.

Upon entering the residence I saw V1 lying on the bed (on his back) in the bedroom. His head was facing E/B, and legs facing W/B.

I did not observe any signs of trauma to V1 body.

I made contact with R/P who told me the following:

On 30 Jan 14, at approximately 2030hrs, V1 had returned to the residence [REDACTED] E 16TH ST) after completing his work day. The RP spoke to V1 briefly and then went to sleep. On 31 Jan 14, at approximately 0800hrs, R/P went to V1 bedroom to wake him up for a [REDACTED] appointment today. RP advised that V1 was [REDACTED] and that V1 had [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, I observed Rosa LONGORIA (V1) lying in her [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] V1 was lying supine on her bed with OFD's CPR compression machine applying compressions to V1's chest. OFD and PmP was attempting to resuscitate V1. V1 did not have a Do Not Resuscitate order and due to V1's next of kin's [REDACTED] wish to keep V1 alive, OFD and PmP attempted to resuscitate V1.

APPROXIMATELY 1722 HRS I WAS DISPATCHED TO THE RESIDENCE LOCATED AT [REDACTED] CANYON OAKS DR APARTMENT #G TO INVESTIGATE A REPORT OF AN UNEXPLAINED DEATH AT THAT RESIDENCE. OPD OFC A. MOLINA-YESEN 9128P WAS ALREADY ON SCENE AND ADVISED THE FOLLOWING HAD OCCURED:

UPON OFC A. MOLINA-YESEN'S ARRIVAL OFD UNIT #E26 AND PP+ UNIT #2131 WERE ALREADY ON SCENE. EMERGENCY PERSONEL RESPONDED TO THE AFOREMENTIONED RESIDENCE TO INVESTIGATE A REPORT OF A PERSON WHO WAS UNCONSCIOUS INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. EMERGENCY PERSONEL LOCATED PABLO GORGE (VICTIM#1) INSIDE THE RESIDENCE AND ATTEMPTED TO RESCUCITATE V1 WITH NEG RESULTS. PP+ PARAMEDIC S. SULLIVAN ADVISED OFC A. MOLINA-YESEN THAT V1 HAD BEEN PRONOUNCED DEAD AT 1654 HRS.

I ENTERED THE AFOREMENTIONED RESIDENCE AND OBSERVED V1 LYING IN SUPINE POSITION ON THE INTERIOR FLOOR OF THE HOME JUST A FEW FEET PAST THE FRONT ENTRANCE DOOR. V1'S BODY WAS COVERED WITH A YELLOW PLASTIC COVER. OFC A. MOLINA-YESEN ADVISED ME THAT PARAMEDICS FIRST LOCATED V1 LYING ON HIS RIGHT SIDE ON TOP OF A BED LOCATED INSIDE V1'S BEDROOM. UPON ARRIVAL PARAMEDICS HAD MOVED V1'S BODY TO THE FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE SINCE THE BEDROOM WAS TOO SMALL TO ACCOMODATE ALL OF THE MEDICAL PERSONEL AND EQUIPMENT.

V1 WORE DARK BLUE SWEAT PANTS AND NO OTHER ITEMS OF CLOTHING. V1'S SKIN WAS NOTICEABLY JAUNDICED, ESPECIALLY IN THE LOWER EXTREMITIES (FEET AND HANDS). I OBSERVED A PURPLISH-COLORED BRUISE ON V1'S LOWER STOMACH AND SEVERAL SMALL BRUISES ON BOTH V1'S KNEES.

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I DID NOT OBSERVE ANY OBVIOUS SIGNS OF FOUL PLAY.

I WENT TO V1'S BEDROOM AND OBSERVED SEVERAL LARGE DARK BROWN-COLORED STAINS ON THE CARPETED FLOORS AND BED. UPON CLOSER EXAMINATION THE STAINS APPEARED POWDERY, SIMILAR IN TEXTURE AND COLOR TO GROUND COFFEE. I OBSERVED A SMALL PORCELAIN CUP ON A SMALL TABLE NEXT TO THE BED WHICH CONTAINED A SMALL AMOUNT OF THIS DARK-BROWN SUBSTANCE. THERE WERE TWO EMPTY BOTTLES OF WINE AND A SMALL EMPTY BOTTLE OF ALCOHOL STREWN ABOUT ON THE BEDROOM FLOOR.

I LATER SPOKE TO [REDACTED] (REPORTING PERSON). THE R/P EXPLAINED THAT V1 WAS [REDACTED] V1, ACCORDING TO THE R/P, HAD BEEN A HEAVY ALCOHOLIC FOR THE PAST THIRTY YEARS. V1 CONSUMED A PINT OF VODKA PER DAY. V1 HAD BEEN UNEMPLOYED FOR THE PAST SIX YEARS AND HAD NOT SEEN A DOCTOR OR GONE TO A HOSPITAL SINCE 2007 [REDACTED]. THE R/P EXPLAINED THAT V1 WOULD OFTEN FALL INSIDE HIS BEDROOM DUE TO HIS CONSTANT STATE OF INTOXICATION, CAUSING BRUISING TO VARIOUS PARTS OF HIS BODY.

OFC A. MOLINA-YEPSEN LATER TOOK A WRITTEN FROM THE R/P. THE R/P STATED THE FOLLOWING OCCURED:

ON 02 FEB 14 APPROXIMATELY 1530 HRS (THE R/P WAS UNABLE TO RECALL THE EXACT TIME) [REDACTED] THE R/P WENT TO V1'S BEDROOM TO ASK IF HE WANTED ANYTHING TO DRINK OR EAT. V1 REPLIED 'NO' AND WENT BACK TO BED. THE R/P THEN TOOK A SHOWER. THIRTY MINUTES LATER THE R/P RETURNED TO V1'S BEDROOM TO CHECK ON HIM AGAIN.

THE R/P OBSERVED V1 LYING ON HIS RIGHT SHOULDER WITH HIS EYES ROLLED BACK TOWARDS HIS HEAD. AN UNKNOWN BLACK SUBSTANCE WAS COMING OUT OF V1'S NOSE AND MOUTH. V1 WAS HAVING PROBLEMS BREATHING. Upon arrival on scene I met with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me this is [REDACTED] residence and he hasn't spoken to [REDACTED], Anthony Armijo (V1), since Christmas 2013. He decided to come by [REDACTED] place to check on him since he hasn't been returning any of his phone calls. He noticed there was mail piled up in front of the door for the past couple weeks.

[REDACTED] told me V1 is [REDACTED]. Also, V1 has been having "medical complications" for the past few months.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] he told me she normally sees V1 however she hasn't seen V1 or anybody coming to or from the house in the past month.

In front of the house I saw over 30 pieces of unopened mail sitting on the front steps. I walked around the house and saw flys in the window of V1's residence. I walked around the back of the house to check to see if anybody was in there and I noticed the windows have been covered up with paper. I wasn't able to see through the windows.

From my observation and [REDACTED] statements I decided to make entry into the house. Because the door was locked and I wasn't able to find somebody with keys to open the door, OFD Truck 6 was called out to force entry. After OFD opened the door I made a tactical announcement in the house and got no response.

Ofc. M. Finnicum and I made entry and I located V1's deceased body in the bedroom. I noticed V1 was laying face down near his bed. His head was in the north direction and feet in the south direction. V1 face and body had fly's around it and I noticed the body had signs of rigamortis and the body had been decomposing. There were no signs of trauma or foul play. On the victims nightstand I noticed several medications that V1 had been taking.

I contacted the Coroner's Office and spoke with Deputy T. Engel #1611. He told me the body would be release to the family and gave me coroner's report number 2014-00406.

Upon arrival, OFD E #20 was already on scene, and I contacted OFD paramedic Pope who pronounced V1 (Wise, Gary [REDACTED]) deceased on 07 FEB 14 at approximately 1222 hours.

I observed V-1 lying on his back on the living room couch. The living room is located in the NE corner of the house. V-1's head was facing NB and his feet were pointed SB, and his arms were at his sides. V-1 was wearing a green robe, red t-shirt, green plaid pants, and white socks. I did not observe any signs of physical trauma to V-1. V-1 appeared to have died from natural causes. I entered V-1's residence and the home appeared clean and organized.

I contacted W-1 ([REDACTED]) who told me the following: On 07 FEB 14, around 1115 hrs, W-1 arrived at V1's house to check the mail and say hello to V1. W1 unlocked the front door with her key and W1 observed V1 lying on the couch. V1 did not say anything to W1 and V1 looked stiff. W1 started to shake V1 but V1 did not respond. W1 advised [REDACTED] that V1 looked deceased and [REDACTED] called 911. W1 advised that V1 suffered from [REDACTED]. I took a signed statement from W-1. See W1's statement for further details.

Based on my preliminary investigation coupled with W-1's statement on 07 FEB 14 at around 1130 hours V1 died from natural causes. According to W-1, V-1 was in [REDACTED]. There were no apparent signs of any lacerations, or gunshot wounds to V1's person. I did not find any pooling of blood, blood trails, or blood splatter near or around V1. There were no signs of struggle in V-1's residence.

Sgt. Wong was notified that the death appeared to be from natural causes.

Summary:

On 08Feb14, approximately 2025 hrs, Ofc. J. Garcia (8888P) and I were working OPD Patrol Unit 2A33, wearing full police uniforms and Ofc. J. Garcia was driving fully marked Patrol SUV #1491. We were dispatched to [REDACTED] 82nd Ave. to assist the Oakland Fire Department in obtaining a coroner for a death.

Upon my arrival, I contacted OFD member Jose YANEZ (20664). YANEZ provided me with a copy of his "EMS FIELD NOTES." He advised me that the deceased, Johnnie BRYANT (V1 BRYANT), was last seen alive two (2) days prior, suffered from [REDACTED] pronounced dead at 2024 hrs, and there were no signs of trauma or foul play. YANEZ advised he was associated with Engine #23. I saw Paramedics Plus Rig #2213 was also on scene.

I walked up the driveway on the south side of [REDACTED] 82nd Ave., to a garage on the southwest corner of the property. From the end of the driveway, I could smell a strong odor of decomposition. I walked up the driveway to the garage, and saw its door, on the east side of the structure's north wall, was open. The single light on the ceiling of the room was on. The garage appeared converted into a living area, with a dresser, a twin sized bed, two (2) sofas, a microwave, and a television set furnishing the single room.

I saw V1 BRYANT lying supine on a twin-sized bed along the south wall of the structure. His head was pointing towards the west, his feet pointing towards the east, and his arms were resting along the length of his body. He was fully clothed, wearing a DBL jacket, BLU jeans, and BLK socks. He appeared to be bloated, with areas of GRN decomposition visible on his abdomen and face. Dark liquid pulled on his face, settling around his eyes and above the bridge of his nose. I did not see any signs of trauma on V1 BRYANT's person. The smell of decomposition was strongest within the room.

I did not see any signs of a struggle around V1 BRYANT's body. I did not see any containers of alcoholic beverages in plain view, within V1 BRYANT's home.

Ofc. J. Garcia spoke with [REDACTED], who said she found V1 BRYANT's body. Ofc. J. Garcia took a signed written statement from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that on 08Feb14, approximately 2015 hrs, she came

I asked her if he appeared intoxicated at the time, and she responded by saying V1 BRYANT was always drunk. She said she went back to his garage with [REDACTED] and they both located his body.

I contacted Coroner M. Neill (#1863) at the Alameda County Sheriff's Department, and advised him of the incident. He provided me with the coroner report number of 2014-00448, and advised me to release V1 BRYANT's body to the responding mortuary.

[REDACTED] contacted [REDACTED] for V1 BRYANT. [REDACTED] from the [REDACTED] arrived on scene and took custody of V1 BRYANT's body.

I saw the lock plate on the doorway of the garage was removed from the frame, and lying on the ground by the front door.

Upon my arrival at approximately 1536 hours, OFD rig E-4 and PMP rig 2117 were on scene. I was directed to [REDACTED]. The apartment was located in the N/W corner of the complex. I made contact with OFD paramedic Dasse 9136, who advised me V1-BANNON, David was inside the residence, lying on a couch in the front living room and had been deceased for approximately one week. V1's time of death was pronounced at 1529 hours on today's date.

I entered the residence and immediately noticed a foul smell emanating from inside the apartment. I observed a single daybed in the middle of the apartment's front room. V1 was lying on the daybed. V1 was wearing a white long sleeved shirt under a short sleeved blue T-shirt, no pants or underwear and white socks. V1 was lying on his back with his head facing N/W. V1's left arm was raised above his head and his head was resting on the left arm's bicep. There was a black and white striped sheet laying across V1's torso area. V1's skin was a greenish gray color, his right cornea was collapsed and cloudy. Blood and fluid had drained from V1's left eye, mouth and nose. Both lividity and rigor had set in. I did not observe any signs of obvious trauma on V1's body.

Sgt. M. Rowley was advised V1's death appeared to be natural.

I observed numerous bottles of medication located on the floor near V1's daybed. The medications included [REDACTED]. I also observed numerous empty bottles of wine, sake and vodka on the floor near the bed and throughout the residence.

I located V1's birth certificate and SSC inside an envelope which was inside an open cabinet in the kitchen. I located V1's CA DL and medical card inside a backpack that was in the living room area. I was unable to develop any information that would lead me to next of kin for V1. I was unable to determine the last time V1 was seen alive.

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Ofc. Bermudez took a written statement from RP- [REDACTED]

RP had not be able to get in touch with V1 since 05 Feb 14 when rent was due. RP had called V1 numerous times, left messages but received no response. On today's date at approximately 1505 hours, RP went to V1's apartment to check on his well being. RP entered the apartment and saw V1 on the couch in the living room. RP called out to V1 but got no response and did not see V1's chest moving up and down. RP also smelled a strong odor inside the apartment. RP called 911. RP had not seen or talked to V1 since middle of Dec 2013 but stated RP paid his rent in Jan 2014. RP stated he knew V1 drank excessively at times. (See statement for complete details)

Upon arrival I was met by OP-2 [REDACTED] who directed me to [REDACTED] V-1 Fontenot, Rhonda residence at [REDACTED] Holway St who appeared not to be breathing.

Upon entry into the open front door of [REDACTED] Holway St., I noticed Fontenot sitting on the floor upright against a sofa. Fontenot's feet were facing south, with her head tilted back, mouth wide open and her eyes looking towards the ceiling. Fontenot's eyes were glossed over and body was cold to the touch. The air in the house was very thick and had a foul odor.

I advised radio I needed code 3 medical.

I checked Fontenot for a pulse with negative results. I repositioned Fontenot's body to the floor to administer CPR. I started chest compressions and was relieved by PMP. PMP took over medical aid.

OFD Engine #18 was on scene and assisted with medical.

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PMP pronounced Fontenot at 0010.07 hours on 11 FEB 14.

Fontenot's death appeared to be of natural causes with no signs of visible trauma on her body.

I found a container of prescription pills located inside a purse in a back bedroom. A majority of the vials label was removed and severally faded. It is unknown to me the type and qaunity of pills the vial contained.

AC CO Deputy T. Engel recovered two vials of prescription medication with labels partially removed from a drawer in the dinning room. It is unknown to me what type of medications the vials contained.

Upon entry into the residence, I observed that the living conditions in the house were very poor. The house was very dirty, with garbage and other random items stacked and piled all over the house. The house had no power or running water. There were cat feces scattered throughout the house. The refrigerator and freezer contained moldy food items that had been there for some time.

Ofc. A Humphrey took a written statement from OP-1 [REDACTED] who said the following.

OP-1 said that at about 1930 hours, she parked her car in the 5500 block of Holway St., she walked by Fontenot's house and heard Fontenot's voice, she said, "Hey [REDACTED] OP-1 said "Hey" back. On 12 Feb 14, at 0806 hours, I was working as OPD patrol unit 1J25 with Ofc. M. Moreno. We were wearing full police wool uniforms. I was driving fully marked patrol vehicle 1756. Ofc. M. Moreno was seated in the front passenger seat. At this time we were dispatched to [REDACTED] ason St to investigate a DOA.

Upon arrival I spoke with OFD medic B. Hicks who informed me that he pronounced RAMIREZ, Edgardo deceased at 0805 hours. I collected the field strip read out from Hicks P20990 (it was turned in with the RP's statement).

I observed the body lying on his back on a bed in the living room. His head was facing north and feet were facing south. There did not appear to be any trauma to the body. The body was in full rigor and lividity had set in, he was cold to the touch.

I met with the RP, [REDACTED] She speaks only Spanish, I took a statement from her and it was translated by [REDACTED] She stated the following:

[REDACTED] Edgardo was seen last night at [REDACTED] He appeared to be in good spirits and was acting normal. Edgardo had [REDACTED] He was being treated by [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] He had a history of drinking and had been drinking Tequila for the past three days. [REDACTED] was so advanced that he was [REDACTED] She went to bed around 2200 hours on 2/11/14, with Edgardo awake on the bed in the living room. She did notice Edgardo had not taken his prescribed medication last night. She was awoken in the morning at 0600 today, by [REDACTED] who found him unresponsive. She called to him and noticed he was not breathing and unresponsive. She then called 911, who arrived and pronounced him.

I contacted Deputy Bordi 1879 of the ALCO Coroner's Office and notified him of the DOA. He created report 2014-00492. He released the body to the family.

I notified 1L74 that the death appeared natural.

[REDACTED] was contracted for the funeral services. I contacted [REDACTED] and spoke with [REDACTED] who informed me the body was going to be removed from the residence by her staff.

Apparently, the Victim who had a medical history of [REDACTED] was awake and well last night. He had been drinking alcohol per his family for the past three days and the RP also advised he did not take his prescribed medications last night. This morning around 0600 hours the RP found the Vict unresponsive. She observed him lying on his back on a bed in the living room. She attempted to wake him up but he was not breathing. She called 911 and OFD medic Hicks pronounced him deceased at 0805 hours. Its apparent the Victim expired at an unk time during the night.

No known witnesses located or interviewed.

No one was handcuffed or searched.

No force used or observed.

My PDRD was not activated because no suspects on scene.
