Summary:

On 19 FEB 15 at 2237 hrs., I was working as OPD Patrol unit 3L23. I was wearing full police uniform and operating fully marked OPD patrol vehicle #1481. At the above date and time, I responded to 4251 International Blvd. to investigate a report of a shooting that had just occurred.

As I arrived on scene at 2241 hrs., Ofc. R. Spring 9305P, had just arrived as well. I observed V1 [REDACTED] laying on his back on the pavement. [REDACTED] was laying directly in front of (IFO) the 7-Eleven store, located at 4251 International Blvd., approximately 50 ft. southwest from the southwest corner of High St. and International Blvd. [REDACTED] feet were facing westbound, head facing eastbound, and hands by his side. There was also blood on the pavement and [REDACTED] was bleeding from the back of his head.

I also observed [REDACTED], laying on top of [REDACTED] and pushing down on [REDACTED] abdomen area. I contacted [REDACTED] and advised [REDACTED] to move to the side while Ofc. Spring and I attempt to determine [REDACTED] well being status. As [REDACTED] removed her hand, I noticed that [REDACTED] suffered a gunshot wound (GSW) to the abdomen area, and it was not bleeding. Since I noticed that [REDACTED] was bleeding from behind his head, I attempted to determine if [REDACTED] suffered another GSW by turning his head, and I was unable to determine. [REDACTED] was not conscious or aware when we arrived on scene. Ofc. Spring and I attempted multiple sternum rubs to try and revive [REDACTED] with negative results.

Since [REDACTED] was still unconscious, I checked [REDACTED] pulse rate using his left wrist, and I could feel a faint pulse. At this time, Ofc. Spring and I started to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on [REDACTED]. Ofc. Spring performed the chest compressions, while I performed mouth to mouth on [REDACTED]. Ofc. A. Esparza 9355P later arrived on scene, and assisted me and Ofc. Spring with CPR. After approximately 5 minutes of CPR, Ofc. Spring, Ofc. Esparza, and myself were relieved by OFD Eng. 18 and PMP 4205. [REDACTED] was later pronounced deceased on scene at 2252 hrs. by Paramedic Brian Fukuhara #P30895.

As we arrived on scene, [REDACTED] was also on scene, standing in front of the Valero Gas Station sign

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at the southwest corner of High St. & International Blvd. Ofc. C. Lewis 9217P, who responded to assist, contacted [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was provided medical attention on scene, since [REDACTED] stated that she had just been peppered spray. [REDACTED] was later transported by PMP 2213 to ACH for further medical evaluation. Ofc. B. Perry 9249P followed PMP. Refer to Ofc. Perry's supplemental report for further details.

After [REDACTED] was medically cleared, [REDACTED] was then transported to CID for questioning. After questioning, [REDACTED] was then transported back to her residence in Richmond by Ofc. Spring.

Additional units responded and assisted with securing the scene via posting of crime scene tape and traffic control posts. Ofc. C. Lewis initiated a crime scene log. Ofc. M. Cannella 9269P later took custody of the crime scene log after Ofc. C. Lewis left the scene.

Ofc. A. Alcantar 9315P responded to the scene to assist. Ofc. Alcantar took a written statement from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] A stated the following:

On 19 JUN 15 at approximately 2230hrs, [REDACTED] and his friend [REDACTED], had just parked at the Valero/7Eleven gas station located at 4251 International Blvd. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] parked at Pump #12 facing towards International Blvd. At this time, [REDACTED] observed a male black (MB), dark complexion, early 30's, 5'8", 200, bid, shaven, wearing a blk hat, dark color T-shirt with a patch on his left shoulder, and dark color pants [REDACTED] fighting with a male hispanic (MH) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] then started filming the fight using his cell phone. [REDACTED] saw that [REDACTED] was on top of [REDACTED]. At this time, [REDACTED] observed three other MH's running up to [REDACTED] and started attacking [REDACTED] [REDACTED] got back up, took his green shirt off, and joined the other three MH's in attacking [REDACTED] and the group that were attacking [REDACTED] stopped and moved away from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stood up and walked away stumbling. [REDACTED] started running towards [REDACTED] and continued swinging at and hitting [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stumbled backwards some more and suddenly [REDACTED] heard a gunshot. [REDACTED] saw that the security guard was holding a blk handgun. [REDACTED] believes that the reason why [REDACTED] shot [REDACTED] was because [REDACTED] was in fear for his life. [REDACTED] turned over the footage he recorded on his cell phone to Ofc. Spring. [REDACTED] is willing to assist with the prosecution. Refer to [REDACTED] written statement for further details. Refer to Ofc. Alcantar's supplemental report for further information.

Ofc. Spring was able to email the video from [REDACTED] cell phone to his OPD Email. Ofc. Spring later forwarded the email of the video to CID Investigator M. Cardoza 8367 P. Refer to Ofc. Spring's supplemental report for further details.

After being relieved by OFD, Ofc. Esparza then took a written statement from [REDACTED] and she stated the following:

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On 19 JUN 15 at approximately 2235 hrs., [REDACTED] was parked at the south curb line in the 4200 blk of International Blvd. waiting for tacos. At this time, [REDACTED] saw a female and a male walking on the south curb line in the 4200 blk of International Blvd. The male was a MH, 5'6", 130, blk hair, wearing a grin shirt and blur jeans [REDACTED]. I observed [REDACTED] walking up and saying something to the security guard [REDACTED] at 4251 International Blvd. [REDACTED] then punched [REDACTED] in the face knocking [REDACTED] to the ground. [REDACTED] attempted to handcuff [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] resisted and fought [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is not sure what happened since people started crowding around. As the crowd gathered around [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], [REDACTED] suddenly heard a loud bang, which sounded like a gunshot. Once the loud bang went off, people started running away in all directions. As the crowd cleared, [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] standing under the Valero Store sign at the south west corner of High St. & International Blvd. trying to catch his breath. Officers later responded to the scene. Refer to [REDACTED] written statement for further details. Refer to Ofc. A. Esparza's supplemental report for further details.

[REDACTED] was able to capture the altercation between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on her cellphone's camera. [REDACTED] gave consent to review the video that was on her phone. [REDACTED] gave her phone to Ofc. D. Jagar 8817P. I took custody of [REDACTED] cellphone. I turned in [REDACTED] cellphone to CID to download. I later returned [REDACTED] cellphone.

Ofc. K. Anderson 9261P responded to the scene to assist. Ofc. Anderson took a written statement from [REDACTED] and she stated the following:

On 19 JUN 15 at 2230 hrs., [REDACTED] was driving east bound with [REDACTED] passing the Valero Gas Station at High St. & International Blvd. As [REDACTED] was passing the gas station, [REDACTED] saw a fight between a security guard in full uniform with security patches on his arm [REDACTED], and a MH. The MH was wearing a grn shirt with stripes [REDACTED]. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were on the ground and it appears that [REDACTED] was losing since [REDACTED] was on top of him. [REDACTED] parked her vehicle in the empty parking lot across the street from the Valero Gas Station. At this time, two other MH's joined the fight and started attacking [REDACTED]. The first MH was about 5'8", skinny, with one wearing a whi shirt with a print on the front. [REDACTED] does not recall how the second MH looked like or what he was wearing. [REDACTED] heard a gunshot and left immediately. [REDACTED] can possibly identify [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] requests to remain anonymous during this investigation. However, [REDACTED] is willing to assist with the prosecution. Refer to [REDACTED] written statement for further details. Refer to K. Anderson's supplemental report for further details.

Ofc. Cannella responded to assist. Ofc. Cannella took a written statement from [REDACTED] and he stated the following:

On 19 JUN 15 between 2215 hrs. and 2220 hrs., [REDACTED] was working as a cashier at the 7Eleven Store located at 4251 International Blvd. At this time, the security guard [REDACTED] came inside the store and started asking

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me about the two cars parked in our parking stalls. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he does not know anything about those two cars. [REDACTED] went outside and confronted the people who were outside and to told them to move their cars. A MH [REDACTED] started arguing with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] then pushed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] took out his pepper spray and sprayed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] attempted to take [REDACTED] into custody, but [REDACTED] resisted and started screaming. A group of people then started surrounding both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. At this time, our store got busy and I started attending to my customers. While helping my customers, I heard a gunshot from the area where the fight was. I did not see anything because there was a big crowd in front of the store. I had called the police when [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] got into a fight. Refer to [REDACTED] written statement for further details. Refer to Ofc. Cannella's supplemental report for further details.

Ofc. Alcantar took a written statement from [REDACTED] and she stated the following:

On 19 JUN 15 at approximately 2200 hrs. [REDACTED] was walking on High St. towards E. 12th St. [REDACTED] observed a FH [REDACTED] and a MH [REDACTED] engaging in a physical altercation [REDACTED] then saw the security guard [REDACTED] trying to separate [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] punched [REDACTED]. As [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were fighting, [REDACTED] pulled out a blk handgun and shot [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] only heard one gunshot [REDACTED] is unable to identify the shooter. [REDACTED] wants to assist with the prosecution. Refer to [REDACTED] written statement for further details. Refer to Ofc. Alcantar's supplemental report for further details.

I contacted [REDACTED] and I asked [REDACTED] what had happened. At this time, I was unaware that [REDACTED] was involved in this incident. When I asked [REDACTED] this, [REDACTED] stated that he just asked them to move their vehicles. Based on what the residents on scene were yelling out, and what [REDACTED] had just stated, I determined on scene that [REDACTED] is actually involved in this incident and that he possibly might have shot [REDACTED]. Due to the above reasons, I took custody of [REDACTED] handgun and rendered it safe. [REDACTED] handgun was loaded and the safety switch was on as well. I later secured [REDACTED] handgun in the trunk of a patrol vehicle. [REDACTED] was later detained IRO a patrol vehicle.

[REDACTED] was later transported by Ofc. Esparza and Ofc. Lewis to CID for questioning. While at CID, [REDACTED] complained of pain to his arms and shoulders. [REDACTED] was later transported to ACH for medical clearance. After [REDACTED] was medically cleared [REDACTED] was then transported back to CID.

Ofc. L. Urbina 9243P canvassed the area for any video surveillance with the following results:

-4345 International Blvd. / Casa Jimenez - A camera was located facing W/B

No force was used or observed.

It appears that on 19 JUN 15 at approximately 2230 hrs., [REDACTED] was working as an armed security guard at 7Eleven located at 4251 International Blvd. [REDACTED] approached [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] regarding an incident in the parking lot. After a brief verbal exchange, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] engaged in a physical altercation that involved [REDACTED] using pepper spray and baton strike(s) on [REDACTED]. It appeared that [REDACTED] was attempting to handcuff [REDACTED]. During the physical altercation, additional individuals assaulted [REDACTED] by punching and kicking [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] walked away stumbling backwards, while [REDACTED] charged after him. In fear for his life, [REDACTED] hot [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was later pronounced on scene.

Summary:

Today, 19 Jun 15, at about 2250 hrs. I was working OPD late tac unit 5S58 with Ofc. K. Cardana 9208. We were both wearing full police uniform, and Ofc. Cardana was driving fully marked patrol car 1832. We were dispatched to 4251 International Blvd. to assist with a report of a shooting.

Upon our arrival, we were directed by officers on scene to assume a traffic control post in the 1100 block of High St. While on the traffic control post, we were approached by [REDACTED] (S1). [REDACTED] arrived on scene with a male, Hispanic and female, Hispanic who identified themselves as the parents of the deceased.

As [REDACTED] was standing next to our patrol car, I was approached by Ofc. Spring. Ofc. Spring advised me [REDACTED] was on scene at the time of the shooting. Ofc. Spring advised me to detain and handcuff [REDACTED]. I ordered [REDACTED] into a handcuffing position. [REDACTED] complied as I placed, fitted, and double-locked his handcuffs. Sgt. Summary:

On 19 June 2015 at approximately 2245 hours, I was working as 3L38. I was wearing full OPD wool uniform and driving fully marked OPD vehicle #1404. At this time I was dispatched to 4251 International Blvd. to assist in a shooting scene. Upon arrival I later discovered the individual who had been shot had died from his injuries at the scene.

I canvassed the area for witnesses who may have seen the incident. I contacted [REDACTED] (W1) who was sitting inside the driver seat of Veh#1 and along side him in the passenger seat [REDACTED] (W2). #1 was parked in front of pump #12 at the Valero gas station (4251 International Blvd) W1 provided me with a written statement stating the following:

On 19 June 2015 at approximately 2230 hours, W1 and W2 were driving E/B in the 4200 block of International Blvd when they observed a MB, dark complexion, early 30's, 5'8", 200 Lbs, bold, shaven, wearing at the time a black hat, dark color T-shirt with a patch on the left shoulder, and dark color pants (S1), fighting with a MH, wearing a green T-shirt (V1) on the ground at the Valero gas station. W1 then made a S/B turn in the 1300 block of High Street and then pulled into the Valero gas station in front of pump #12 facing N/B to view the altercation. W2 started recording the incident on his cell phone. W1 advised me that S1 was a security guard. W1 stated he saw S1 and V1 on the ground fighting when three MH started to punch and kick S1 in the head. V1 was able to stand up and took off his green shirt and started to join the attack. The group of MH stopped for a few seconds which allowed S1 to stand up on his own. W1 stated S1 stumbled away and appeared to be dizzy and injured. While S1 was stumbling back V1 ran towards S1 and started to swing his fist and hit S1. W1 stated S1 stumbled back when V1 started to attack again and that's when W1 heard the gun shot. W1 then saw S1 holding a black handgun in his right hand. Then S1 started stumbling back towards the Valero gas station sign and people started to approach him but would not get to close. I think the security guard was scared for his life and that's why he shot V1. S1 had been fighting for five minutes. The recording was given to officers. W1 wants to assist in the matter and do the right thing. See statement for further details.

W1 provided the recording taken on his cell phone to officers on scene.

W3 then stated she saw the security guard try and separate the MH and FH. The MH then started to punch and attack the security guard. The security guard then pulled out a black gun and shot the MH. W3 heard one gun shot. W3 then saw the MH fall to the ground. W3 can not identify the shooter. W3 wants to help in the prosecution. See statement for further detail.

SCENE DESCRIPTION:

The 4200 block of International Blvd was a commercial neighborhood. International Blvd was an east and westbound roadway with two lanes of traffic in each direction and left hand turn lanes in both directions at each end of the block. The 4200 block of International Blvd had a center median separating the east and westbound directions of traffic.

The west end of the 4200 block of International Blvd intersected with 42nd Ave. 42nd Ave was a north and southbound roadway with two lanes of traffic in each direction. The intersection of 42nd Ave and International Blvd was controlled by 4-way stop lights.

The east end of the 4200 block of International Blvd intersected with High St. High St was a north and southbound roadway with two lanes of traffic in each direction. The intersection of High St and International Blvd was controlled by 4-way stop lights.

4251 International Blvd was a commercial lot on the south side of the street located on the southwest corner of the intersection of High St and International Blvd. The commercial lot consisted of a "Valero" gas station with a "7-Eleven" convenience store at the southern end of the lot. The gas station consisted of twelve gas pumps located along three sections. Two of the gas pump sections were located on the north side of the lot in front of the 7-Eleven and the third gas pump section was located on the east side of the lot on the east side of the building. There were two driveway entrances on the north property line and two driveway entrances on the east side property line allowing access to the gas station.

There was a black Dodge Durango (lic# [REDACTED]) located along the north side of the building (7-Eleven) at the west end. The Durango was parked facing east. There were logos on the vehicle that stated [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. There was a gold Lexus 4-door (lic# [REDACTED]) parked facing in a southwest direction along the west side property line.

Street lights surrounded the lot and the lot was lit up by lights at the gas pumps and building. Use of flashlights was not necessary to see most evidence and my notes. The weather was cold with a slight breeze.

SUMMARY:

On 19 Jun 15, I was working as a police evidence technician. I was working under the call sign 3C65 wearing full police utility uniform and driving vehicle 3088. At approximately 2242 hours, I heard a dispatch of a shooting come out at 4251 International Blvd. I advised dispatch to show me en route to the call.

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I arrived on scene at approximately 2249 hrs. Once on scene, I noticed several police vehicles blocking traffic on High St and International Blvd surrounding the gas station at 4251 International Blvd. There was yellow crime scene tape up around the northeast area of the lot. There was a large crowd in the gas station lot to the west of the main part of the scene.

I noticed a male victim [REDACTED] on the south sidewalk of International Blvd just west of High St. [REDACTED] was laying in a supine position with his head in an eastern and slightly northern position. OFD personnel were providing medical aid to [REDACTED] who appeared to have a wound to his abdomen (gauze pad placed on top of the wound). There was blood on [REDACTED] head, near the ear and back of the skull. [REDACTED] was not responsive at this time.

There was a female victim [REDACTED] just south of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was laying on her left side, partially facing the ground. She had appeared to vomit and appeared to have been pepper sprayed. [REDACTED] commented that her eyes were burning and that she was sprayed with pepper spray. I informed her that PMP personnel would be arriving soon to give her medical aid.

I took photos of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as they were when I arrived on scene.

Officers on scene were containing the crowd and trying to locate witnesses to the shooting as I arrived on scene.

At approximately 2252 hrs, I was informed that [REDACTED] was pronounced deceased.

I began taking photos of the scene. I located several surveillance cameras on the 7-Eleven building on the lot that could have captured the incident. I took photos of the cameras and their locations.

Officers informed me that a private security guard [REDACTED] that was on scene was the possible shooter and the person that also pepper sprayed [REDACTED].

At approximately 2311 hrs, I obtained gun shot residue (GSR) samples from [REDACTED]. Using a clean pair of gloves, I opened the sealed plastic bag containing the GSR kit. I removed the sterile gloves from inside the package and placed them over my gloves that I already had on. I removed the first vial from the kit, which was for the right hand, and obtained a sample from [REDACTED] right hand. I sealed the vial and placed it back in the GSR kit. I removed the second vial from the kit for the left hand and obtained a sample from [REDACTED] left hand. I sealed the vial and placed it back in the GSR kit. [REDACTED] informed me he was right handed. I collected and secured the GSR kit (item 17) in my vehicle.

I collected [REDACTED] security jacket (item 13) and placed it in a bag. I secured the bag in my vehicle.

I took photos of [REDACTED] and his injuries he stated he had from the incident.

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I began making a rough sketch of the crime scene.

I placed placards at items of evidence.

Officers had informed me that they had collected and secured [REDACTED] body armour vest (item 15), duty belt (item 14 A-G), and semi-automatic pistol (item 16) in the back of a police vehicle (Ford Crown Victoria). I took photos of the items and collected them. I secured the items of evidence in my vehicle.

Technician W CHAN arrived on scene and assisted me in taking my measurements of the location and items of evidence using a stroll-o-meter.

I took additional photos of the scene and evidence.

I located a set of handcuffs (item 1) north and slightly west of [REDACTED] feet. [REDACTED] shoes and socks (item 2 A-B) were located next to his right foot and his clothing (item 3 A-B) was located next to his left foot. There was a paper receipt (item 4) located west of [REDACTED] body along with a blue lighter (item 5). There was a spent bullet case (item 7) north of items 4-5 on the sidewalk. Southeast of items 4-5 was a black baseball cap (item 6). There was also some apparent blood on the ground just north of item 6. A broken pair of glasses (item 8) were located by the northwest gas pump. A white baseball cap (item 9) was located by the front passenger side tire of [REDACTED] vehicle (see above for locations of evidence items).

There was a vehicle (gold Nissan GLE lic# [REDACTED]) located at a gas pump on the east side of the lot that was an apparent witness to the incident. I took photos of the vehicle and its location.

There was a black Dodge Durango (lic# [REDACTED]) that was [REDACTED] work vehicle located on the north side of the building toward the west corner (photos were taken of this vehicle).

There was a gold Lexus 4-door (lic# [REDACTED]) located along the west property line that belonged to [REDACTED] (photos were taken of this vehicle).

At approximately 0043 hrs on 20 Jun 15, homicide investigators Sgt M CARDOZA and Ofc P TRAN arrived on scene. Ofc TRAN left the scene to respond to another homicide that had occurred. Sgt CARDOZA was briefed on the scene and what we had for evidence.

At approximately 0138 hrs, Deputy Coroner A WILLIAMS and Deputy Coroner R PLASENCIA from the Alameda County Coroner's office arrived on scene. Dep Coroner WILLIAMS took photos of the scene.

I collected [REDACTED] cell phone (item 10) that was on top of his abdomen and secured it in my custody.

With assistance from the Dep Coroners, I took photos of [REDACTED] and his injuries.

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At approximately 0200 hrs, Sgt C BASA arrived on scene.

Using sterile swabs and distilled water, I took samples of apparent blood from [REDACTED] left and right hands. I secured the samples in individual swab boxes (item 11 A-B) and secured them in my custody. I also obtained a sample of the apparent blood (item 12) located on the ground near item 6. I placed the sample in a swab box and secured it in my custody.

Sgt CARDOZA informed me that he would like to have [REDACTED] cell phone and the pair of glasses [REDACTED] stated were his). At approximately 0215 hrs, I collected the glasses and Sgt CARDOZA took custody of both items.

I collected the remaining items of evidence and secured all items in my vehicle.

I obtained [REDACTED] keys. Per Sgt CARDOZA, I unlocked and searched [REDACTED] Lexus for any additional items of evidence.

I located an almost empty glass liquor bottle (item 18) on the center console between the driver seat and front passenger seat. I took photos of the bottle and its location. I also located a cell phone on the front passenger side floorboard and in a bag on the front passenger side floorboard, I located a wallet with [REDACTED] ID inside. I took photos of the items.

I collected the bottle for evidence and secured it in my custody. Sgt CARDOZA informed me that he would take the cell phone and wallet with him. I collected the cell phone and wallet.

Sgt CARDOZA took custody of the cell phone and wallet at approximately 0228 hrs. At this time, Ofc J TA'AI took custody of [REDACTED] keys to return to his mother who was located across the street in a parking lot.

I secured all evidence in my vehicle and relocated to the tech detail.

Using my own lock, I secured all the evidence in a locker at approximately 0316 hrs.

I prepared a final diagram to show the scene and locations of items of evidence (see diagram for further).

I uploaded the photos to the secure server.
