FYI, you may want to know about CEC's proposed upcoming [block grants](#) for PEV charger installation, with CEC chipping in \$14m and looking to grow the amount to \$200m, in case this information is useful for your committee meeting tomorrow. In addition CEC sponsored discounted financing is available now through a relatively new program that the California Treasurer's office is eager to publicize. Host sites in MF and disadvantaged communities can get up to 25% of the project cost back.

I have attached the CalCAP/EVCS Financing Program brochure which is a good resource for local permitting offices to share with their residents. The brochure highlights that this loan program that aims to assist small businesses install charging stations at their place of business or in multi-unit dwellings and that it also offers a 15% rebate to the small business once the loan is paid off.
