ORDINANCE No. 7705 C. M. S.

 AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE  
 SEPTEMBER 25, 1967, THE CITY OF OAKLAND  
 TAX IMPOSED ON CIGARETTES BY ORDINANCE  
 NO. 7381 C.M.S., AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of  
 Oakland as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to comply with the require-  
 ments of those provisions of Chapter 963 of the Statutes  
 of 1967 which provide that State cigarette tax revenues  
 may not be allocated to any city imposing a selective  
 local tax on, or with respect to, the sale, distribution,  
 use, consumption, or holding of cigarettes or any other  
 tobacco product, after October 1, 1967, the City of  
 Oakland tax on cigarettes imposed by the provisions of  
 Ordinance No. 7381 C.M.S., effective on July 1, 1966  
 (Article 22 of the Oakland Municipal Code), shall be and  
 become suspended and inoperative on and after September 25,  
 1967, and shall not be imposed thereafter upon cigarettes  
 or their distribution unless and until appropriate action  
 is taken by the City Council to revive said tax and  
 render the same again operative and in full force and  
 effect. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed  
 as relieving any person of the obligation to pay the City  
 of Oakland any tax accrued or owing by reason of the  
 provisions of said Ordinance No. 7381 C.M.S. in force  
 and effect prior to and including September 24, 1967.
