I had a discussion with Pamela about "Tamales Acapulco". Pamela agreed that the correct location address should be 1480 Fruitvale.

Pamela was going to speak to the food trailer owner about her documenting an approved FC or FV permit from the City of Oakland at either 1480 or 1502 Fruitvale, as the City does not show in our database that there were permits issued for the food vendor at that location. The City shows the vendor applied for the FV permits, but they were not issued for some reason.

A permit the City does not issue can not be "renewed".

If it turns out that the City did not issue the food vendor a permit for either location, her options are:

- 1) Between now and June 2nd, apply for a <u>new</u> vehicular food vending permit under the existing program (Chapter 8.09 of the Municipal Code);
- 2) Starting on June 5th, apply for a new food vending permit under the new program.

Pamela will reply to either of us with more information as she receives it from the food vendor.







The City of Oakland wants to provide more opportunity for food vendors to bring additional food choices to under-served areas. City staff are working with the public and the vending community on a new program for permitting food vending in Oakland to replace the current programs. These changes will affect owners and operators of food trucks, trailers, pushcarts and stationary carts.

The main changes proposed in the food vending program are:

- 1. Allow food vending citywide, on private property in areas of the City where it is currently not permitted, including parts of Downtown, North Oakland and West Oakland
- 2. Designate street parking spaces where food vending will be permitted
- 3. Allow "group sites" of two or more vendors to vend together in areas of the City where it is currently not permitted (portions of Central and East Oakland neighborhoods).
- 4. Improve enforcement in order to reduce the number of un-permitted vendors in Oakland neighborhoods.
